Placement Scores attached: Please note that for math, students must reach cut-off scores to go to the next level; therefore, percentages for EACH level shown are percentages of the students who took that level only. For example, (please see attached sheet), of the 55 students who took the General Algebra test, 63.6% achieved a score of 0-39; 30.9% achieved a score of 40-65; and 5.5% achieved a score of 66-100. **What must be noticed is that** only 55 students, or 29%, scored high enough to take the General Algebra, and, only six students, or 3.2 percent of all examinees scored high enough to take the General College Algebra test. These figures work the same on each sheet, and I have penciled in the corresponding percentages.

Note: the reason there are more examinees here than on the other sheet is that retakes ARE INCLUDED.
