As part of assessment of our Pre-Professional AA and AS degree programs we Science/Math faculty members evaluate our graduating students' skills in:

1. Science Content Knowledge and Skills, and Critical Thinking Skills
2. "General Education Competencies" (which are identified in EWC's catalog as: Communication Skills, Analytical & Quantitative Reasoning, Technology Skills, Social Awareness, and Information Literacy).

This assessment process helps us identify areas in our programs that need additional emphasis, and hopefully can help you identify your strengths, and show you areas where you may need improvement.

Assessments are rubrics based, and scored on a scale of 1-4 as follows:

1 = Novice, 2 = Partially Proficient, 3 = Proficient, 4 = Advanced

Science Course Content scores are assessed for each science course by the instructors of those particular courses, and include evaluation of your factual knowledge as well as your laboratory skills.

The rubrics used to assess "General Education Competencies" are included with your score report. Your scores in these areas are averages of the ratings given by each of the pre-professional faculty.
