Articulation Agreements

Articulation agreements are formal agreements between colleges that allow credits to transfer smoothly. EWC administrators and faculty spend hours working with colleges and universities to assure smooth and successful transfer of credits. Student who successfully complete an Associate of Arts or an Associate of Science degree can transfer to regional colleges and universities at the junior level. This can be an incredible time and money saver! Data shows that EWC students who transfer to the University of Wyoming are as prepared and more prepared than those who begin at the University as a freshman. The colleges and universities listed below have current articulation agreements in place with EWC.

*The Western Undergraduate Exchange (WUE) tuition rate is calculated 1.5 times the resident tuition rate. To qualify for the WUE rate, a student must be a resident of Alaska, Arizona, California, Colorado, Hawaii, Idaho, Montana, Nevada, New Mexico, North Dakota, Oregon, South Dakota, Utah or Washington. Nebraska residents will also be eligible for WUE rates.

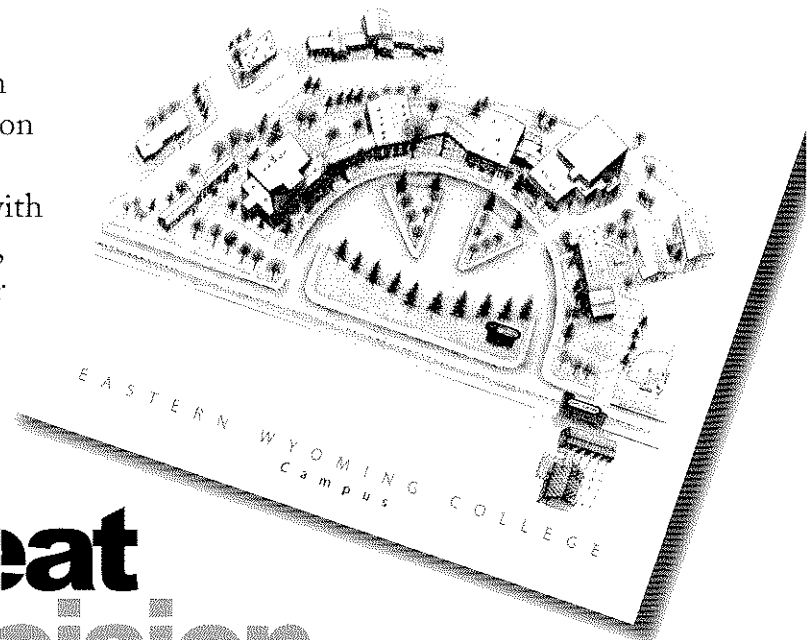

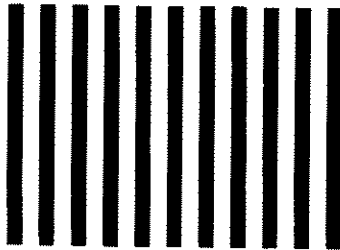
