## **BOMB THREATS/THREAT CALLS**

If a bomb threat is received by phone, do the following:

1. Signal to someone near you to alert one of the persons listed below: *Do not use wireless means of communication which can activate a bomb.*
  - **President** - 8202; 8303

  - **VP Fin Affairs** - 8218

*[These individuals will contact 911 and Physical Plant Director - 8255; 532.8927 (home); 401.0903 (cell)]*
2. Maintain the line.
3. Prolong the conversation as long as possible writing down everything said by the caller.
4. Identify background noises.
5. Note distinguishing characteristics in voice.
6. Ask caller for a description of the bomb, where it is planted and when it is due to explode.
7. Determine the caller's knowledge of the facility
8. Document information gathered as soon as possible.

## **INTRODUCTION**

This manual is designed to provide basic guidance in emergency situations such as bomb threats, chemical spills, fire, gas leaks, weapon situations, and the like. Procedures outlined, along with common sense, are meant to provide general steps to follow in the event of an emergency on the Eastern Wyoming College campus. When placing emergency calls, stay on the line to provide all the information needed. Please review these procedures periodically along with more detailed information provided in the Crisis Plan.

## **GAS LEAK**

## **DISASTER**

---

A disaster is any event or occurrence which has taken place and has seriously impaired or halted the operations of the college. In some cases, mass casualties, and severe property damage may be sustained. A coordinated effort of all campus-wide resources is required to effectively control the situation. Outside emergency services will be essential. However, if the destruction is county-wide, fire/medical/police service may be delayed or unavailable. An Emergency Operations Center (EOC) will be activated, and College and county services will be used to govern the disaster response.
