[Oxford Music Online](#)

Oxford Music Online is the gateway offering users the ability to access and cross-search multiple music reference resources in one location. With *Grove Music Online* as its cornerstone, Oxford Music Online also contains *The Oxford Companion to Music* (revised 2011), which offers more than 8,000 articles on composers, performers, conductors, instruments and notation, forms and genres, and individual works; and *The Oxford Dictionary of Music*, 2nd edition (revised 2006), which supplements Grove's more-extensive articles with content geared toward undergraduates and general users.

[Naxos Music Library](#)

Naxos Music Library is the world's largest online classical music library. Currently, it offers streaming access to more than 91,020 CDs with more than 1,323,400 tracks, standard and rare repertoire. Over 800 new CDs are added to the library every month.

[American Song](#)

American Song is a history database that allows people to hear and feel the music from America's past. The database includes songs by and about American Indians, miners, immigrants, slaves, children, pioneers, and cowboys. Included in the database are the songs of Civil Rights, political campaigns, Prohibition, the Revolutionary War, the Civil War, anti-war protests, and more. Content from African American Music is now a part of American Song, including 17,000 tracks from the original interface, plus 18,000 newly released tracks.
