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EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The Spring 2017 headcount decreased 2.3% and the FTE increased 0.9%. Full-time headcount was up 35 students and part-time headcount was down 71 students resulting in a total decrease of 36 students. The number of first time students in Spring 2017 was up 10 full-time student and down 58 part-time students. The number of students who had attended EWC anytime prior to Spring 2017 was up 25 full-time students and down 13 part-time students. Goshen County was down 2 full-time students and down 21 part-time students, and Outreach increased by 37 full-time students and decreased by 50 part-time students. Goshen County FTE decreased by 11.96 FTE, and Outreach increased by 20.92 FTE. Outreach accounted for 45% and Goshen County accounted for 55% of the FTE.

Credit course offerings are provided as regular courses in both Goshen County and most of the 12 outreach sites. In addition, concurrent enrollment in the high schools, and distance learning courses are also offered. Goshen County courses generated 556.41 FTE of which 6.29% were from concurrent enrollment courses, 7.74% from evening courses, and 36.0% from distance education courses. Concurrent enrollment courses generated 43.0% of the 455.75 FTE from Outreach.

The 113 distance education courses served 215 students living in EWC's outreach areas or Douglas campus and 251 students living in Goshen County for a total of 466 students. However, 184 (73.3%) of the 251 students in Goshen County were also enrolled in regular day courses. Distance education courses meet the needs of busy working adults and also regular on-campus students.

Developmental courses are offered for those students who do not have college level skills in reading, writing, and mathematics. There were 127 students enrolled in developmental courses, which accounted for 3.52% of the FTE. Of the 127 students enrolled in developmental courses, 64 of those students are seeking an associate degree or certificate.

The total Spring 2017 headcount was 1534 students. Of those students, 962 (62.7%) were non-degree seeking. High School students accounted for 657 (68.3%) students of the 962 non-degree

seeking students. The programs with the largest enrollments were Interdisciplinary Studies, Welding & Joining Technology, and Veterinary Technology.

Eastern Wyoming College provides numerous non-credit and Workforce Development offerings. EWC's non-credit enrollment was 698 students compared to 2062 students in Spring 2016. EWC's Workforce Development efforts provided 54 credit courses totaling 121.67 FTE and 7 non-credit courses meeting for a total of 27 contact hours to provide further educational opportunities for individuals in or preparing to enter the workforce.

The Spring 2017 full-time students came from 16 states and 9 foreign countries. Most of the students came from five states: Wyoming, Nebraska, Colorado, South Dakota, and Montana. Within Wyoming, the full-time students came from 23 counties, with the majority coming from Goshen, Converse, Weston and Laramie. The gender distribution for all credit students was 42.5% male and 57.5% female. The ethnicity distribution was 88.5% white non-Hispanic, 7.1% Hispanic, and 4.5% all others. The average age of students enrolled in credit courses was 25.08 with a 22.08 average for full-time students and a 26.50 average for part-time students.

EWC FINAL ENROLLMENT SPRING 2017

EWC experienced a 2.3% decrease in total student headcount as compared to Spring 2016. The total student headcount of 1534 students reflects an overall decrease of 36 students. Total full-time enrollment was up 35 students and total part-time enrollment was down 71 students compared to Spring 2016. Spring 2017 enrollment was 157 students below the five-year average.

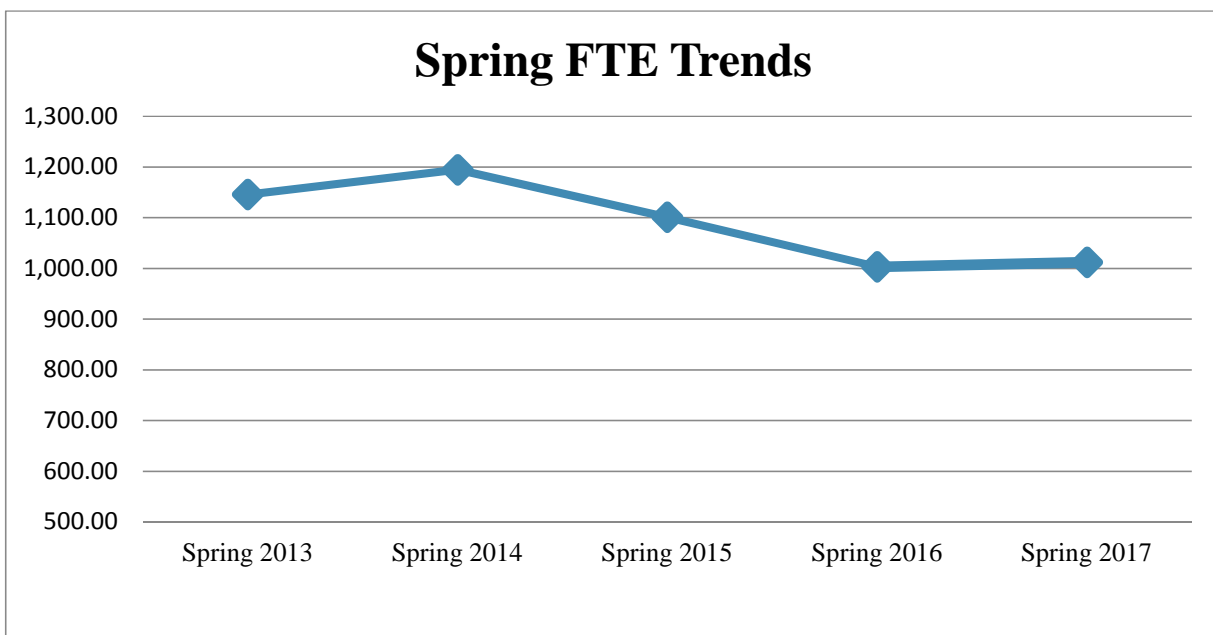
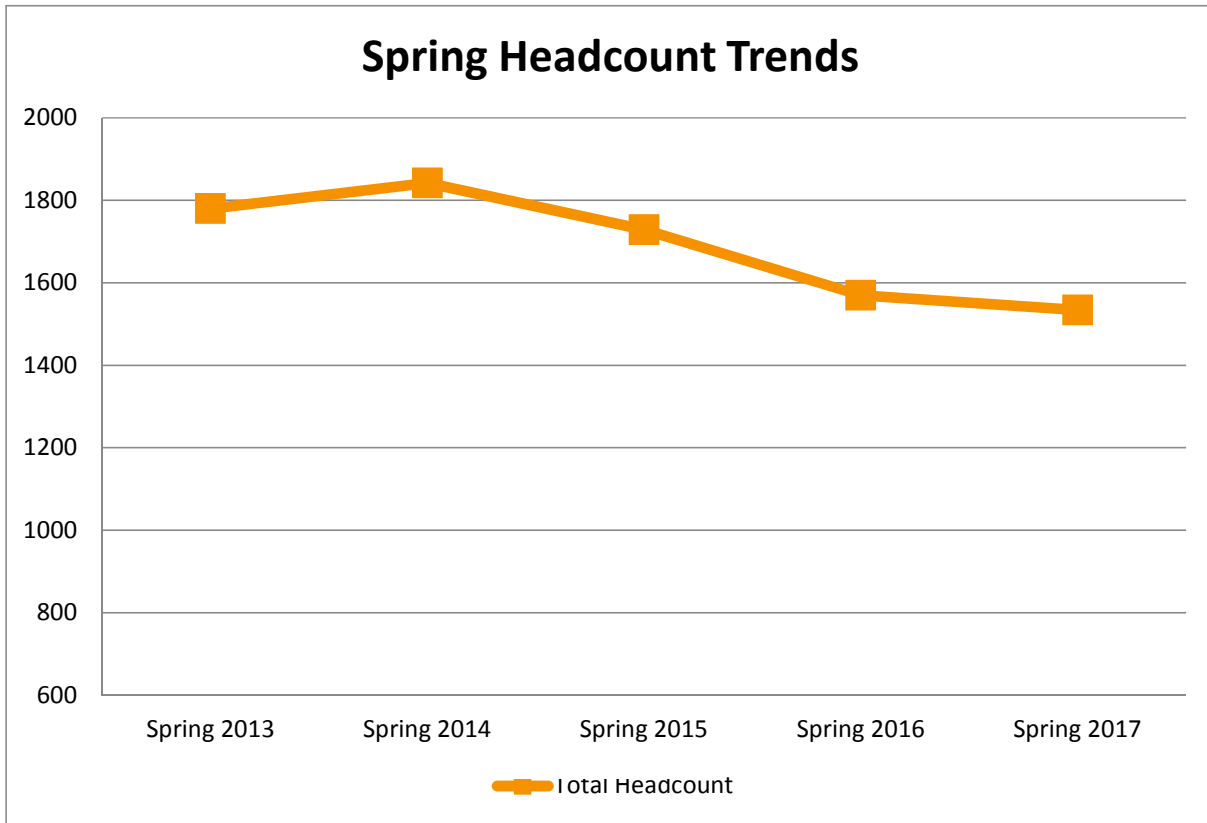

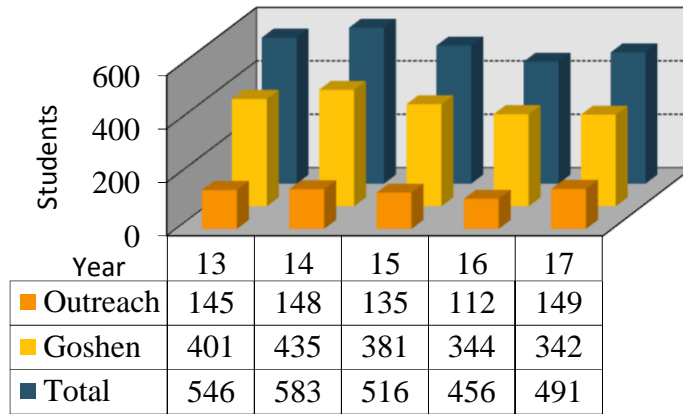
SPRING FULL-TIME HEADCOUNT

EWC experienced an increase of 37 (33%) full-time students in Outreach enrollment and a decrease of 2 (0.6%) students in Goshen County for a total increase of 35 (7.7%) students as compared to Spring 2016. Outreach full-time headcount was 11.2 students above the five-year average. Goshen County was 38.6 students below the five-year average for an overall 27.4 students below the five-year average.

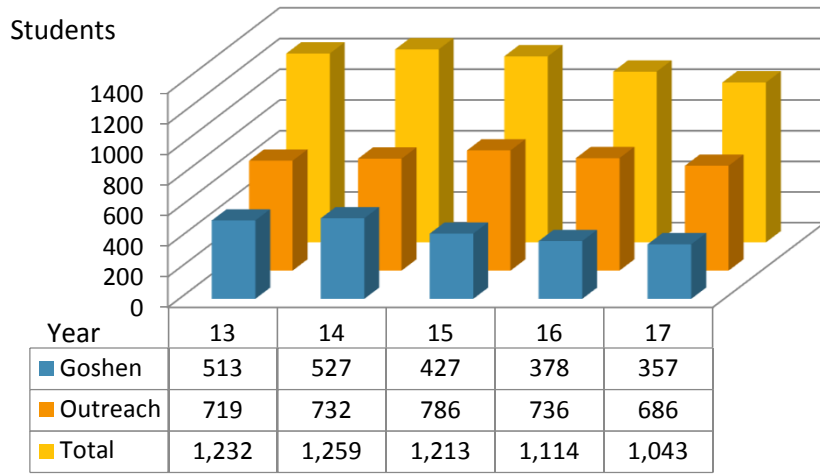
SPRING PART-TIME HEADCOUNT

EWC experienced an decrease of 50 (6.8%) part-time students in Outreach enrollment and a decrease of 21 (5.6%) students in Goshen County for a total decrease of 71(6.4%) students as compared to Spring 2016. Spring 2017 Outreach part-time headcount was 45.8 below the five-year average, and Goshen County part-time headcount was 83.4 below the five-year average. The total part-time headcount was below the five-year average by 129.2 students.

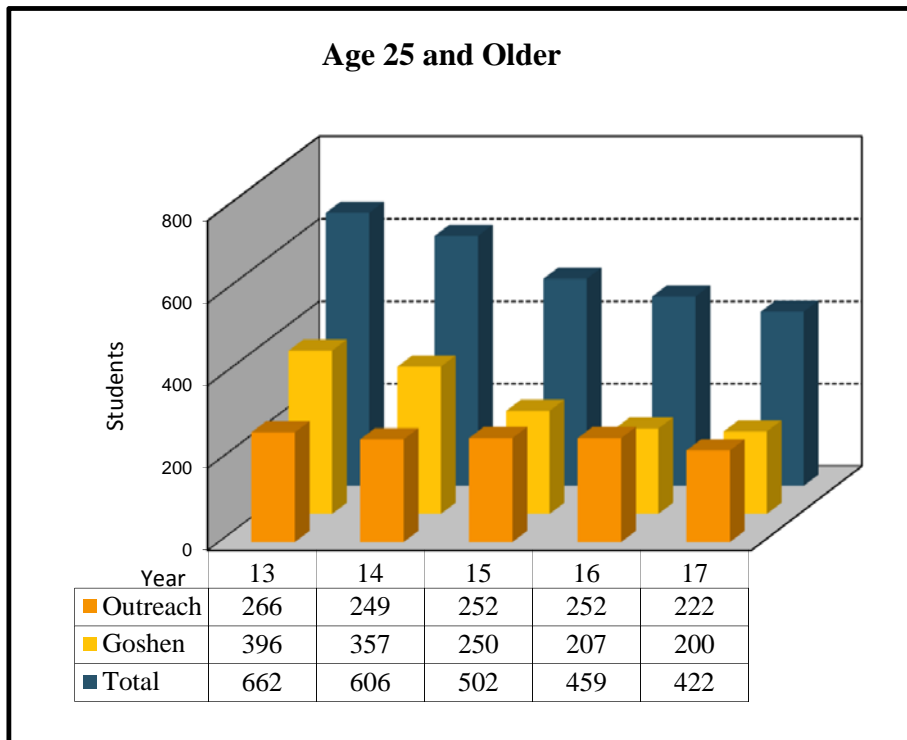
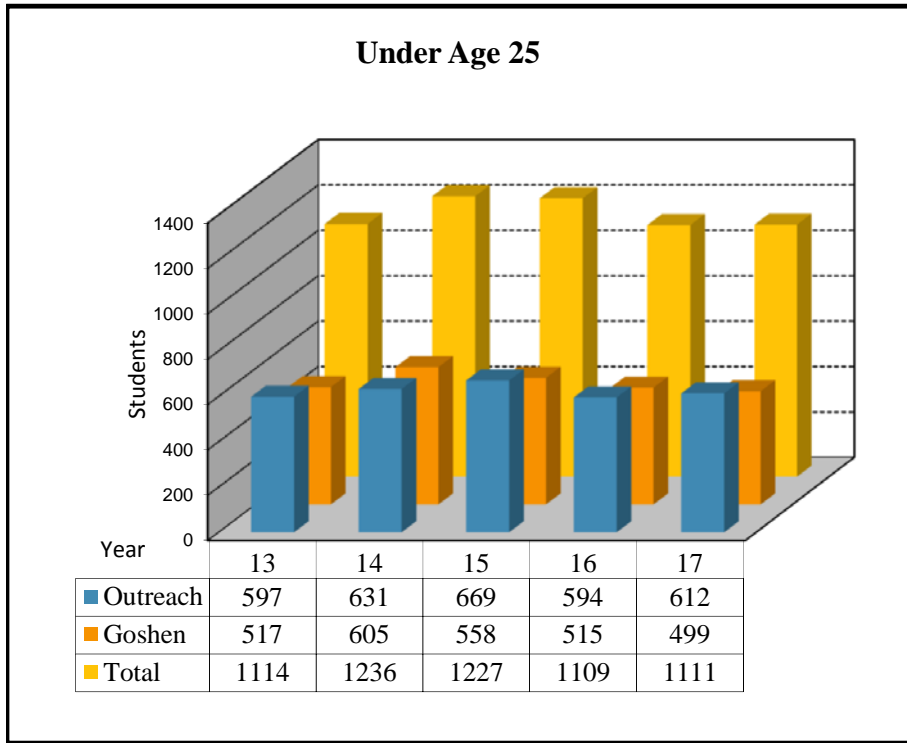

SPRING AGE UNDER 25/AGE 25 AND OLDER



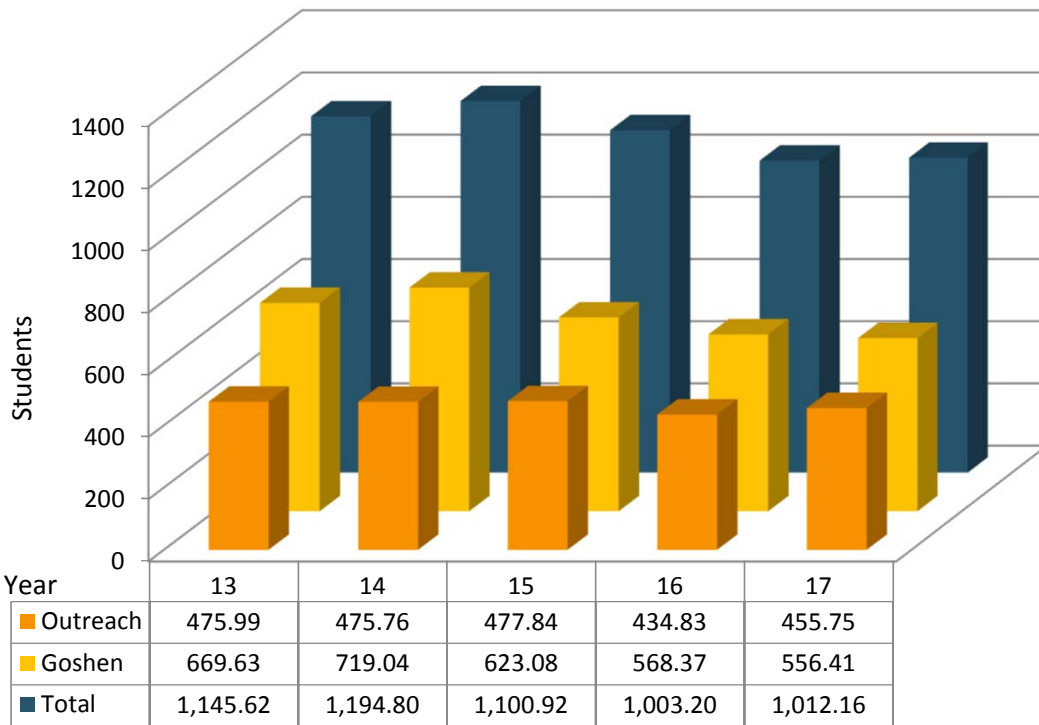
SPRING FTE BY LOCATION

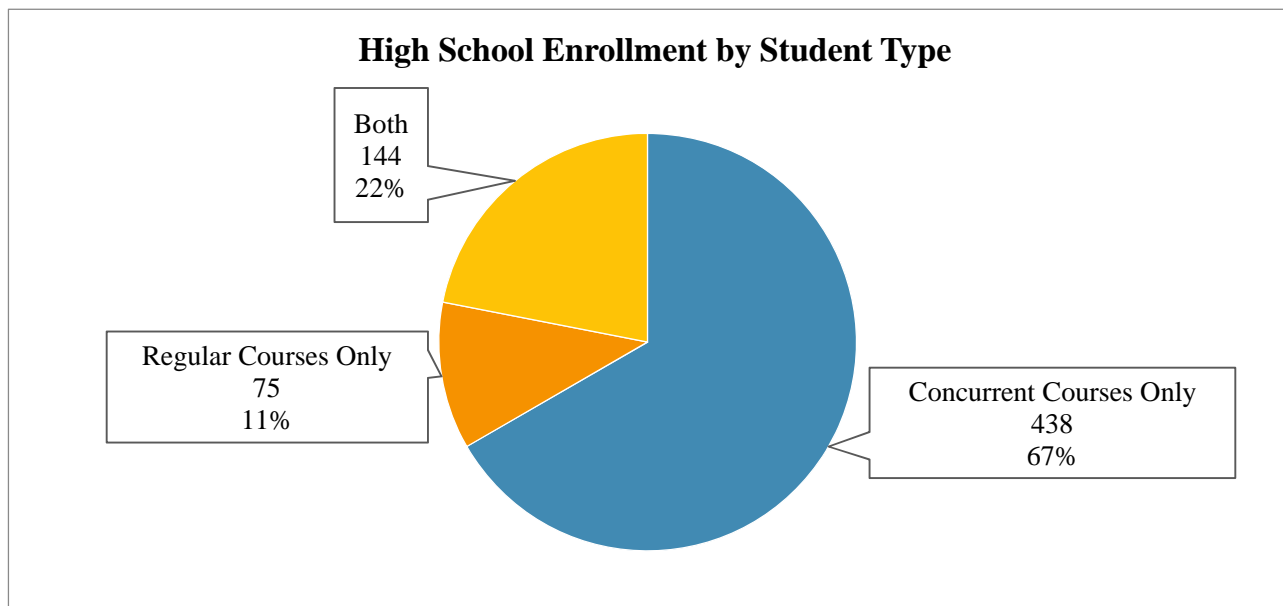

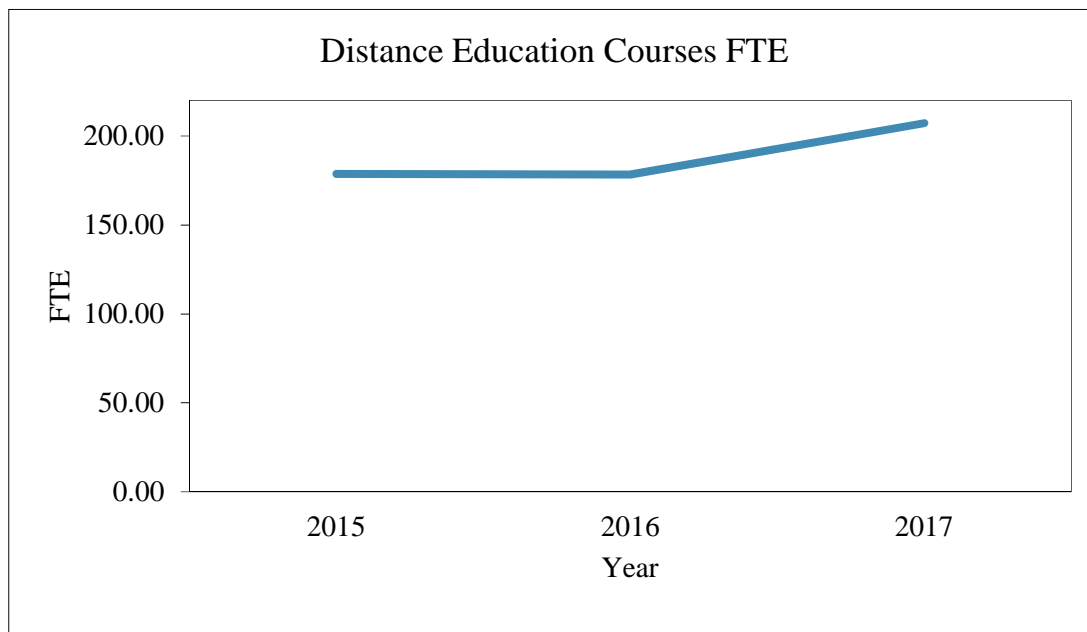
SPRING DISTANCE EDUCATION COURSES

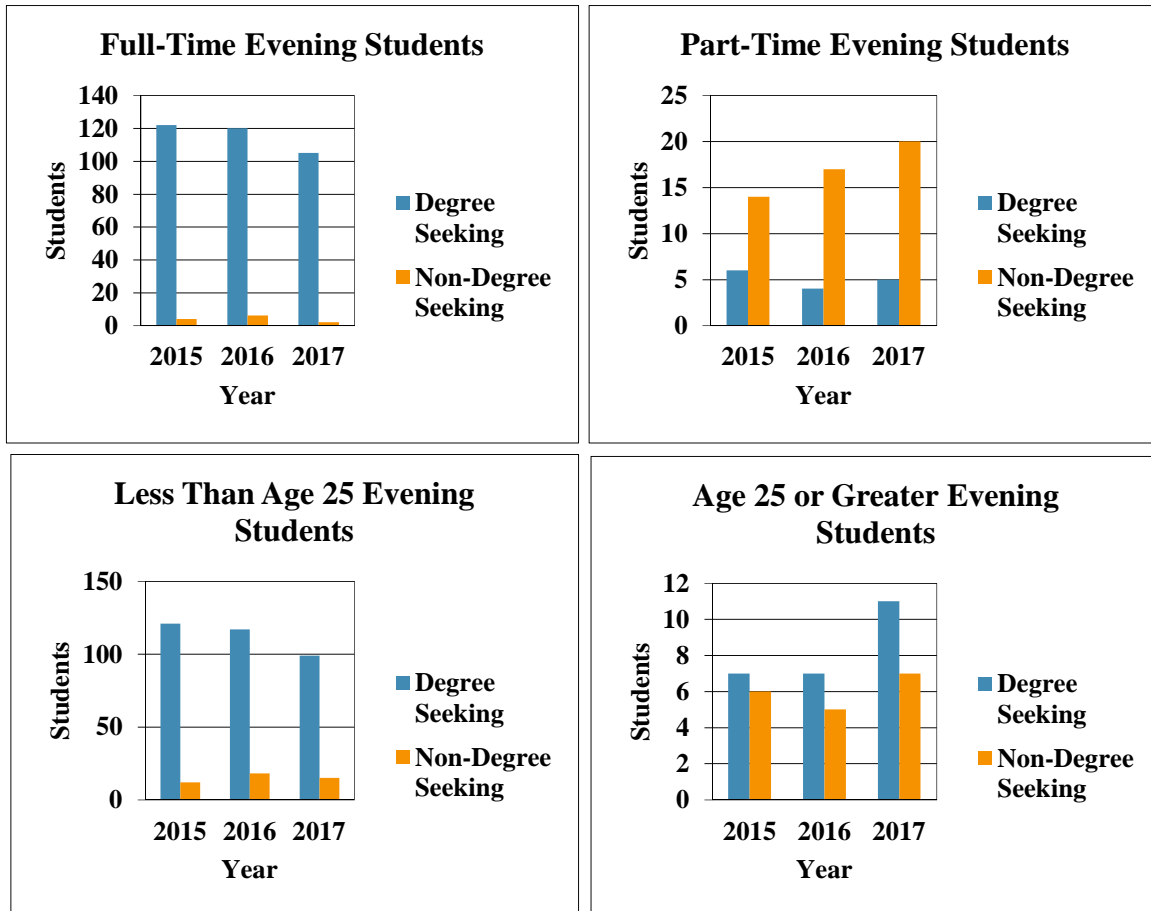

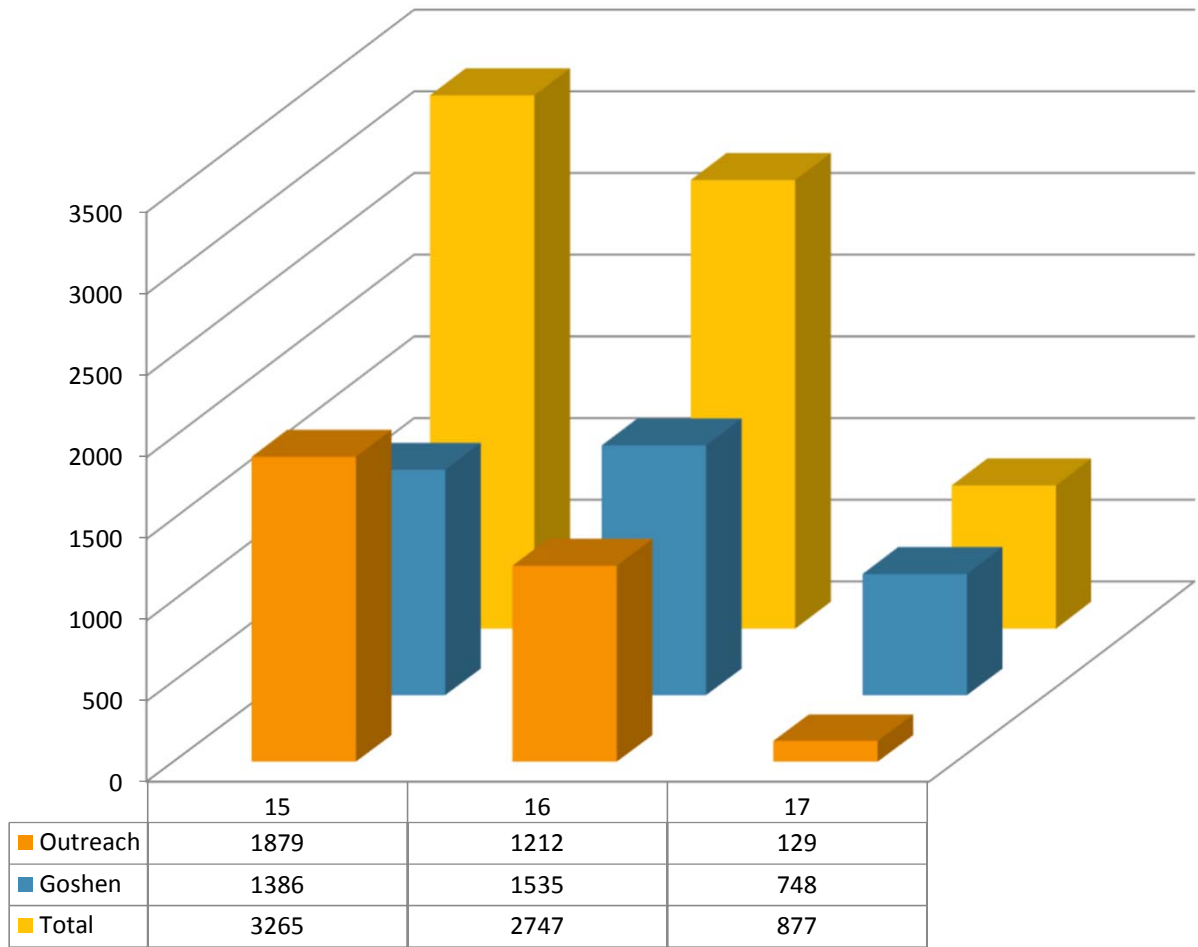
