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EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The Fall 2017 headcount decreased 2.2% and the FTE decreased 7.8% compared to Fall 2016. Full-time headcount was down 58 students and part-time headcount was up 20 students resulting in a total decrease of 38 students. The number of students who attended EWC for the first time in Fall 2017 was down 23 full-time students and up 40 part-time students. The number of students who had attended EWC anytime prior to Fall 2017 was down 35 full-time students and down 20 part-time students. Goshen County was up 24 full-time and up 11 part-time students, and Outreach decreased by 82 full-time and increased by 9 part-time students. Goshen County FTE increased by 19.25 FTE, and Outreach decreased by 114.67 FTE. Outreach accounted for 41% of the FTE.

Credit course offerings are provided as regular courses in both Goshen County and the 12 outreach sites. In addition, concurrent enrollment in the high schools, and distance learning courses are also offered. Outreach had 63.3% of its 460.25 FTE from concurrent enrollment courses. Goshen County courses generated 668.67 FTE of which 5.9% were from concurrent enrollment courses, 5.1% from evening courses, and 24.7% from distance education courses.

One of the challenges in scheduling courses is determining the time and delivery method that will best serve the largest number of students and accommodate the needs of non-traditional and site bound students. Some of the on-campus day students do enroll in distance learning and/or evening courses. The 110 distance education courses served 194 students living in EWC's outreach areas and 242 students living in Goshen County for a total of 436 students. However, 159 (65.7%) of the 242 students in Goshen County were also enrolled in regular on-campus day courses. Similarly, the 23 on-campus credit evening courses served a total of 138 students with 121 (87.7%) of the students also enrolled in regular on-campus day courses.

Developmental courses are offered for those students who do not have college level skills in reading, writing, and mathematics. Developmental courses enrolled 156 students (9.44% of total students) which accounted for 4.04% of the FTE. Of the 156 students enrolled in developmental courses, 104 (66.7%) of those students are seeking an associate degree or certificate.

The total Fall 2017 headcount was 1652 students. Of those students, 1049 (63.5%) were non-degree seeking. The programs with the largest enrollments were Interdisciplinary Studies, Welding & Joining Technology and Veterinary Technology. Eastern Wyoming College provides numerous non-credit and workforce development offerings. EWC's non-credit enrollment was 561 students compared to 719 students in Fall 2016.

The Fall 2017 full-time students came from 17 states and foreign countries. Most of the students came from five states: Wyoming, Nebraska, Colorado, South Dakota, and Montana. Within Wyoming, the full-time students came from 22 counties, with the majority coming from Goshen, Converse, Platte, Weston, Laramie, and Crook. The gender distribution for all credit students reflects 43.6% male and 56.4% female. The ethnicity distribution was 86.6% white non-Hispanic, 9.6% Hispanic, and 3.8% all others. The average age of students enrolled in credit courses was 23.4 with a 20.6 average for full-time students and a 24.7 average for part-time students.

FALL 2017 ENROLLMENT SUMMARY

EWC experienced a decrease of 2.2% in total student headcount as compared to Fall 2016. The total student headcount of 1,652 students reflects an overall decrease of 38 students.

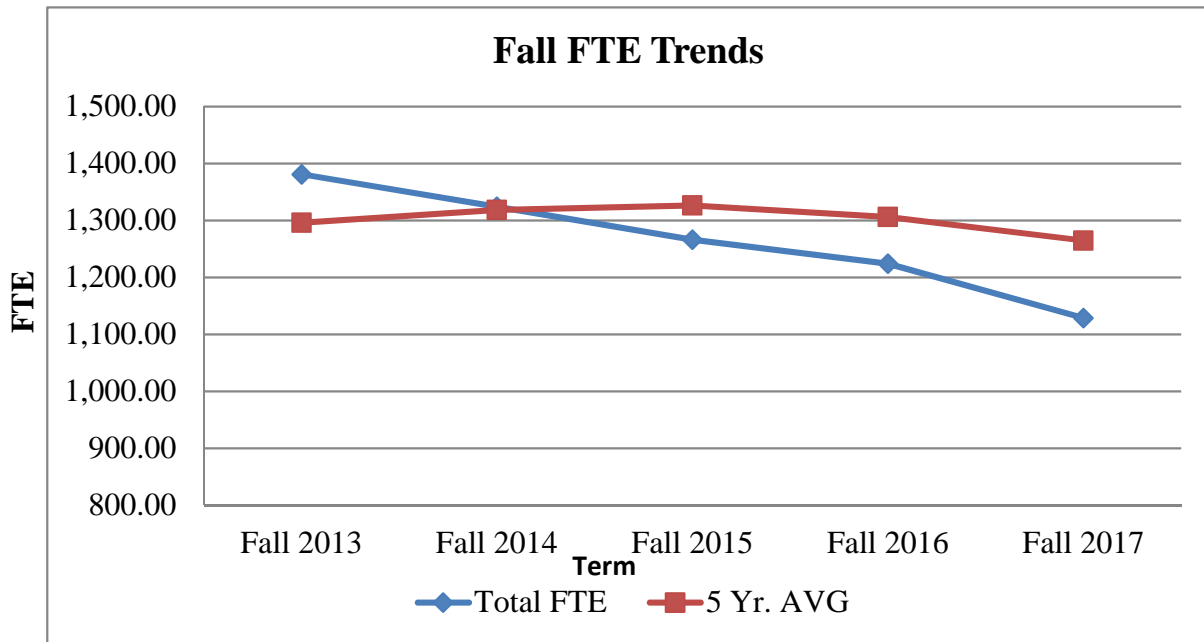
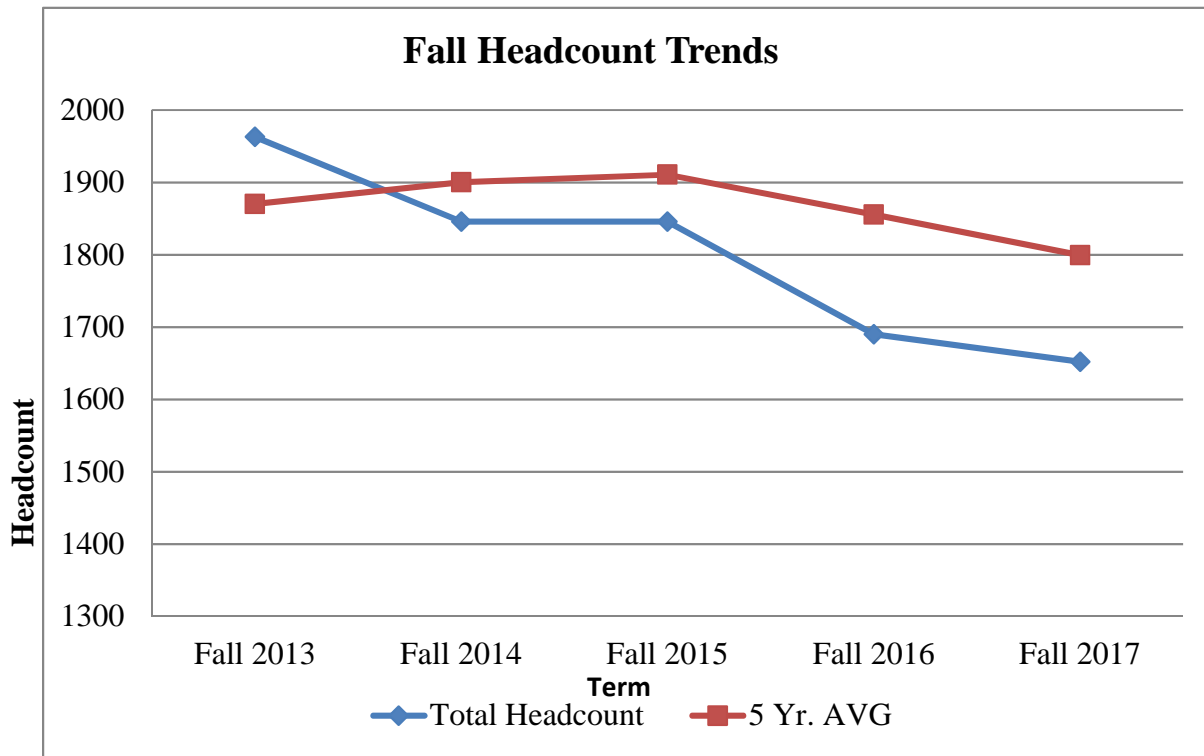

FALL FULL-TIME HEADCOUNT

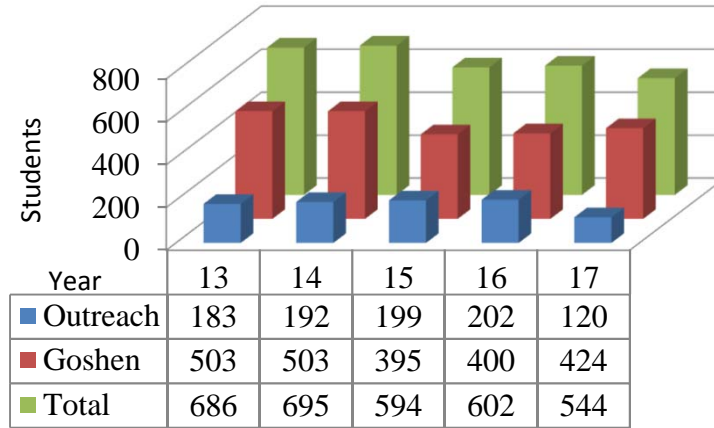

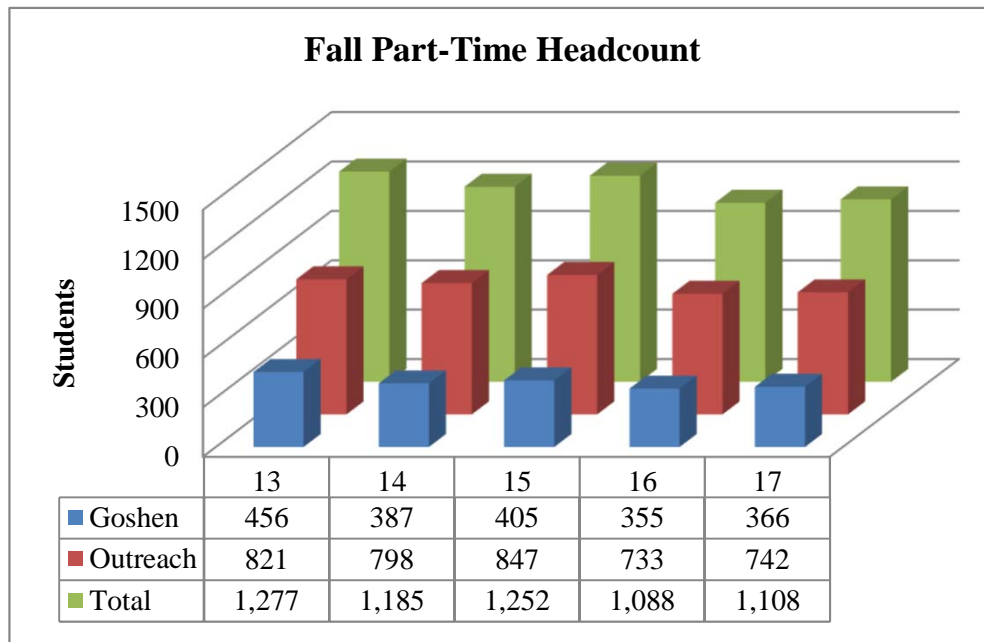

FALL AGE UNDER 25/AGE 25 AND OLDER



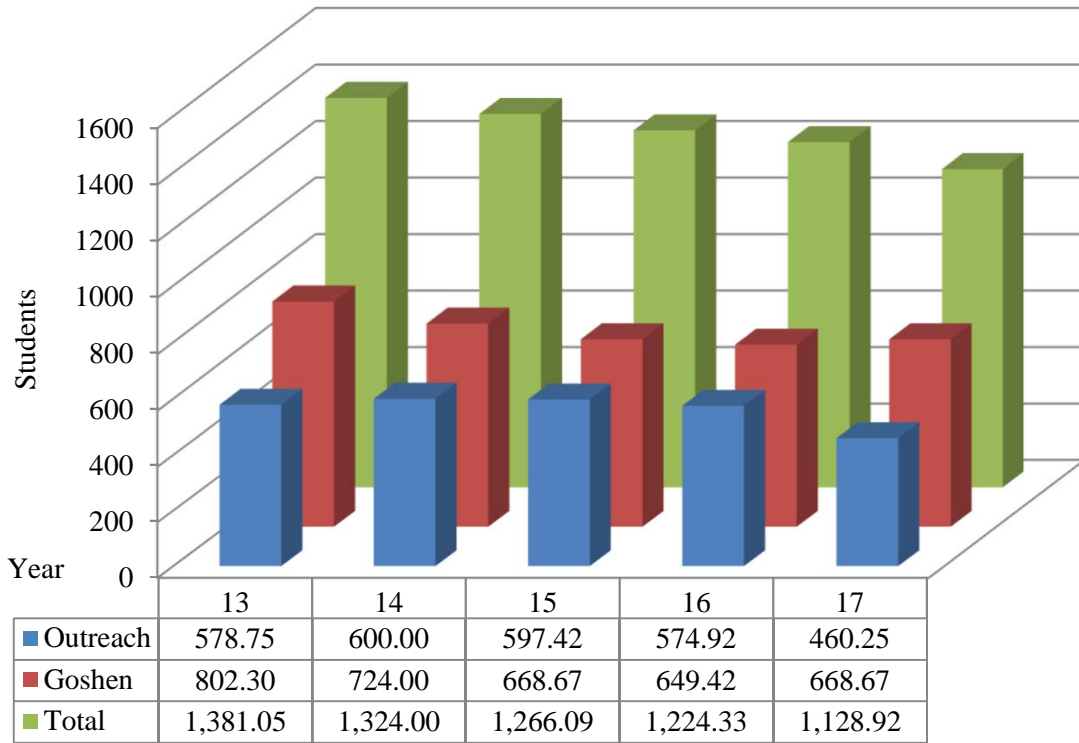
FALL FTE BY LOCATION

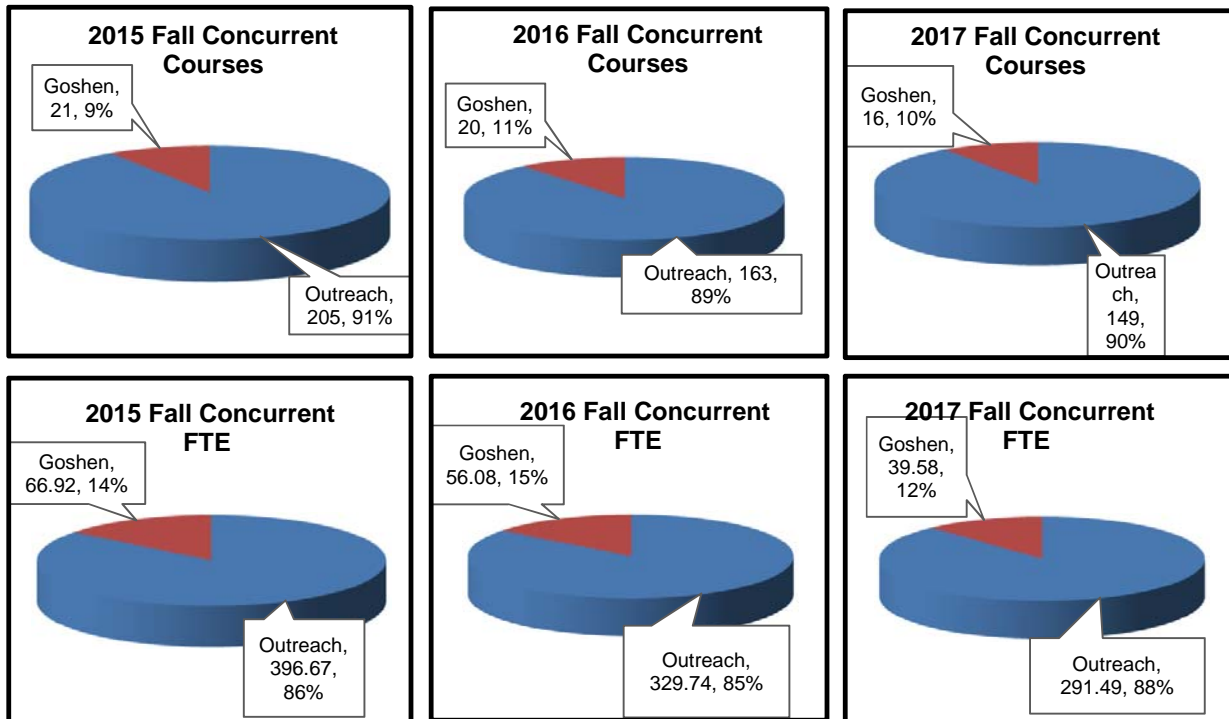
FALL FTE BY STUDENT LOCATION

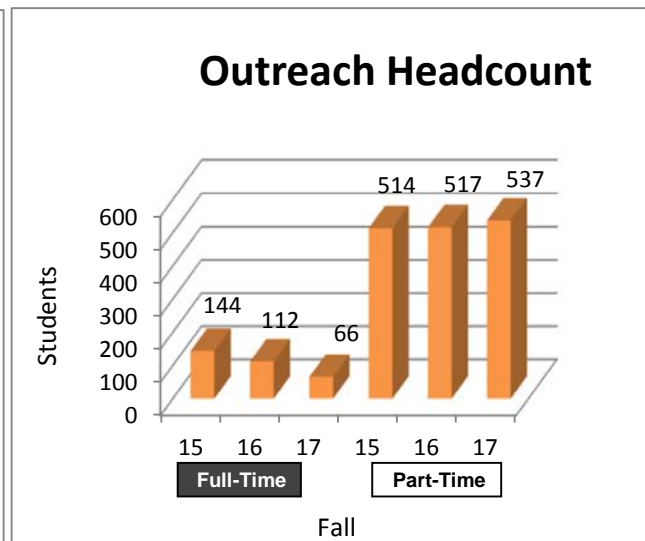
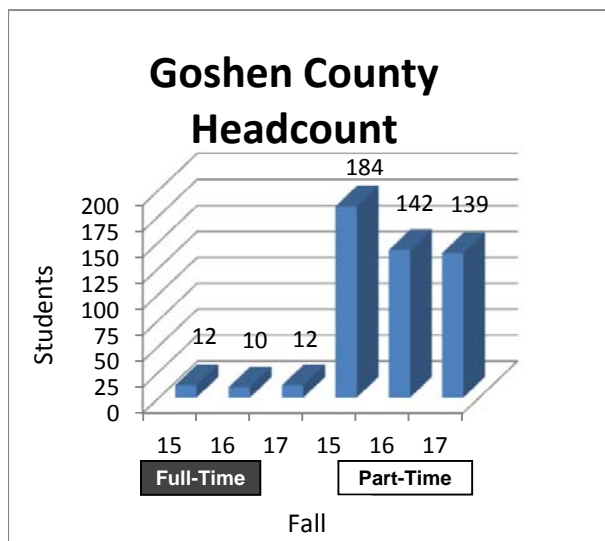


FALL HIGH SCHOOL STUDENT HEADCOUNT

Credit Courses

EWC's workforce development offerings for college decreased by 3 sections compared to Fall 2016. The duplicated student headcount decreased by 62 (15.1%) students, and the FTE decreased by 9.01 (11.2%) FTE. Workforce FTE represented 6.3% of total FTE.
