In order to maintain a Hathaway Scholarship, students must meet Hathaway GPA (GPA), Continuous Enrollment (CE), and Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP) requirements. GPA, CE, and SAP status are assessed at the end of each Spring semester for those receiving Hathaway in the Fall and/or Spring. GPA is also assessed for Summer semesters.

Cumulative Hathaway GPA (GPA) Requirements:

<i>Honors</i>	2.50	<i>Please note that the Hathaway GPA will often differ from the GPA listed on the EWC transcript. Hathaway GPA does <u>not</u> include classes completed before initiating the scholarship or remedial/developmental coursework. The Hathaway GPA <u>does</u> include Hathaway transfer credits.</i>
<i>Performance</i>	2.50	
<i>Opportunity</i>	2.25	
<i>Provisional Opportunity</i>	2.25	

Continuous Enrollment (CE) Requirements:

A student must enroll in coursework for every Fall and Spring semester once he/she has initiated their Hathaway Scholarship. Students can enroll at any WY community college or the University of Wyoming to maintain continuous enrollment.

Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP) Requirements:

Once the Hathaway Scholarship has been initiated, students must take a minimum of six (6) college credits (1000 level courses or above) in order to maintain SAP. SAP is based off of credits paid by Hathaway and are calculated as follows:

- **Part-time students** must complete at least twelve (12) college-level credits by the end of spring semester;
- **Part-and full-time students** who attend one semester at part-time status and one semester at full-time status must complete at least eighteen (18) college-level credits by the end of the spring semester;
- **Full-time students** must complete at least twenty-four (24) college-level credits by the end of spring semester.

Please note: Students who attend only for the Spring semester must meet the split of the outlined SAP requirements. Students who attend the entire year have the Fall and Spring semester to meet requirements. *Example: a full-time student could complete 10 credits in the Fall, and 14 credits in the Spring and still maintain eligibility (24 credits).*

Students must maintain all of the above requirements to remain eligible for the scholarship. Students who have lost eligibility may regain Hathaway by successfully completing the steps outlined below. Steps to regain are based off of the reason(s) students have lost eligibility. Please note that Hathaway will not fund semesters used to regain (or attempted to regain) eligibility.

Issue	Steps to Regain* (Summer semesters may be used to regain GPA only. Summer semesters do <u>not</u> count towards SAP/CE).
GPA	If a student loses the scholarship due to failure to maintain the appropriate Hathaway GPA, Hathaway funds will be rescinded until the first academic semester/term occurring after the Hathaway GPA has been restored. ¹
SAP	If a student loses the scholarship due to failure to maintain SAP, Hathaway funds will be rescinded until the first academic semester/term occurring after SAP has been restored. ² Summer cannot be used to reestablish SAP.
CE	If a student loses the scholarship due to failure to maintain continuous enrollment in an eligible institution, Hathaway funds will be rescinded until he/she enrolls & completes one academic term as a full-time or part-time student, whichever is applicable ³ . Summer term cannot be used to reestablish continuous enrollment.
GPA and SAP	If a student loses the scholarship due to failure to maintain the appropriate Hathaway GPA and SAP, Hathaway funds will be rescinded until the first academic semester/term occurring after the Hathaway GPA and SAP has been restored. ¹
GPA and CE	If a student loses the scholarship due to failure to maintain the appropriate Hathaway GPA and CE, Hathaway funds will be rescinded until he/she enrolls & completes one academic term and the first semester occurring after the Hathaway GPA has been restored.
SAP and CE	If a student loses the scholarship due to failure to maintain SAP and CE, Hathaway funds will be rescinded until he/she enrolls & completes one academic term and the first semester occurring after SAP has been restored.
All 3 (GPA, SAP, CE)	If a student loses the scholarship due to failure to maintain the appropriate Hathaway GPA, SAP and CE, Hathaway funds will be rescinded until he/she enrolls & completes one academic term and the first semester occurring after the Hathaway GPA and SAP have been restored.

*Semesters of ineligibility count against the six-year time frame for scholarship use. Remedial credits cannot be used to regain Hathaway.

¹An Honor or Performance level student whose GPA drops no lower than a 2.25 can receive Opportunity level until a GPA of 2.5 + is restored.

²Students who lose eligibility due to SAP must enroll and complete a minimum of six (6) non-remedial credits to regain.

³Students who lose eligibility due to CE must regain based on the enrollment status, full-time or part-time, of the last semester attended.
