## EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The Fall 2019 headcount increased 4.0% and the FTE increased 0.6% compared to Fall 2018. Full-time headcount was down 12 students and part-time headcount was up 75 students resulting in a total increase of 63 students. The number of students who attended EWC for the first time in Fall 2019 was up 10 full-time students and up 68 part-time students. The number of students who had attended EWC any time prior to Fall 2019 was down 22 full-time students and up 7 part-time students. Goshen County had same full-time and was up 19 part-time students, and Outreach decreased by 12 full-time and increased by 56 part-time students. Goshen County FTE increased by 9.33 FTE, and Outreach decreased by 2.25 FTE. Outreach accounted for 43.3% of the FTE.

Credit course offerings are provided as regular courses in both Goshen County and most of the 12 outreach sites. In addition, concurrent enrollment in the high schools, and distance learning courses are also offered. Goshen County courses generated 627.50 FTE of which 8.06% were from concurrent enrollment courses, 5.29% from evening courses, and 30.15% from distance education courses. Concurrent enrollment courses generated 49.97% of the 478.83 FTE from Outreach.

One of the challenges in scheduling courses is determining the time and delivery method that will best serve the largest number of students and accommodate the needs of non-traditional and site bound students. Some of the on-campus day students do enroll in distance learning and/or evening courses. The 71 distance education courses served 186 students living in EWC's outreach areas and 263 students living in Goshen County for a total of 449 students. However, 195 (74.1%) of these 263 students in Goshen County were also enrolled in regular on-campus day courses. Similarly, the 23 on-campus credit evening courses served a total of 115 students with 93 (80.9%) of these students also enrolled in regular on-campus day courses.

Developmental courses are offered for those students who do not have college level skills in reading, writing, and mathematics. There were 142 students enrolled in developmental courses, which accounted for 3.84% of the FTE. Of the 142 students enrolled in developmental courses, 104 of those students are seeking an associate degree or certificate.

The total Fall 2019 headcount was 1635 students. Of those students, 1022 (62.5%) were non-degree seeking. High School students accounted for 765 (74.9%) students of the 1022 non-degree seeking students. The programs with the largest enrollments were Interdisciplinary Studies, Welding & Joining Technology, and Veterinary Technology.

Eastern Wyoming College provides numerous non-credit and Workforce Development offerings. EWC's non-credit enrollment was 443 students compared to 594 students in Fall 2018. EWC's Workforce Development efforts provided 41 credit courses totaling 108.33 FTE and 4 non-credit courses to provide further educational opportunities for individuals in or preparing to enter the workforce.

The Fall 2019 full-time students came from 16 states and foreign countries. Most of the students came from 4 states: Wyoming, Nebraska, Colorado and South Dakota. Within Wyoming, the full-time students came from 23 counties, with the majority coming from Goshen, Converse, Laramie, Crook and Platte.

The gender distribution for all credit students was 42.3% male and 57.7% female. The ethnicity distribution was 84.7% white non-Hispanic, 9.5% Hispanic, and 5.7% all others. The average age of students enrolled in credit courses was 24.0 with a 21.4 average for full-time students and a 25.2 average for part-time students.

### EWC Final Enrollment Fall 2019

EWC experienced an increase of 63 students (4.0%) in total headcount as compared to Fall 2018. The total student headcount was 1635. The full-time enrollment went down 12 students and the part-time enrollment went up 75 students compared to Fall 2018. The enrollment in Fall 2019 was 44.0 below the 5 year average.

EWC experienced an increase of 0.6% in FTE compared to Fall 2018. The FTE was 58.7 below the 5 year average.

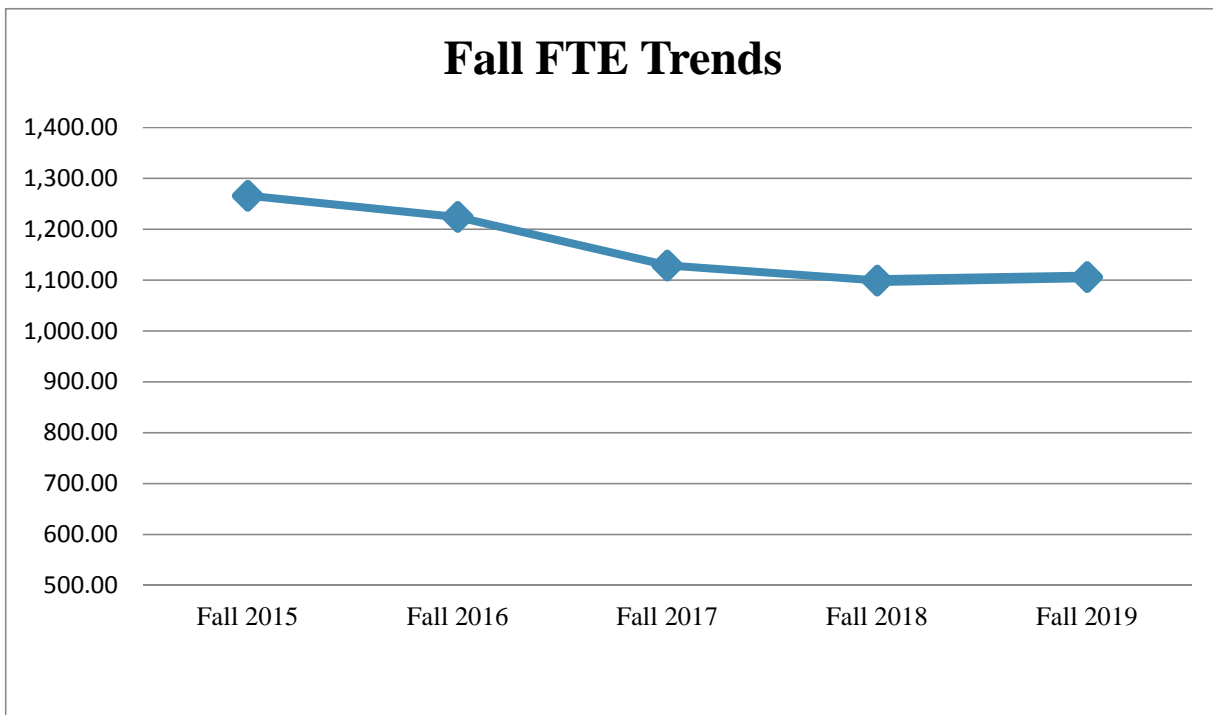
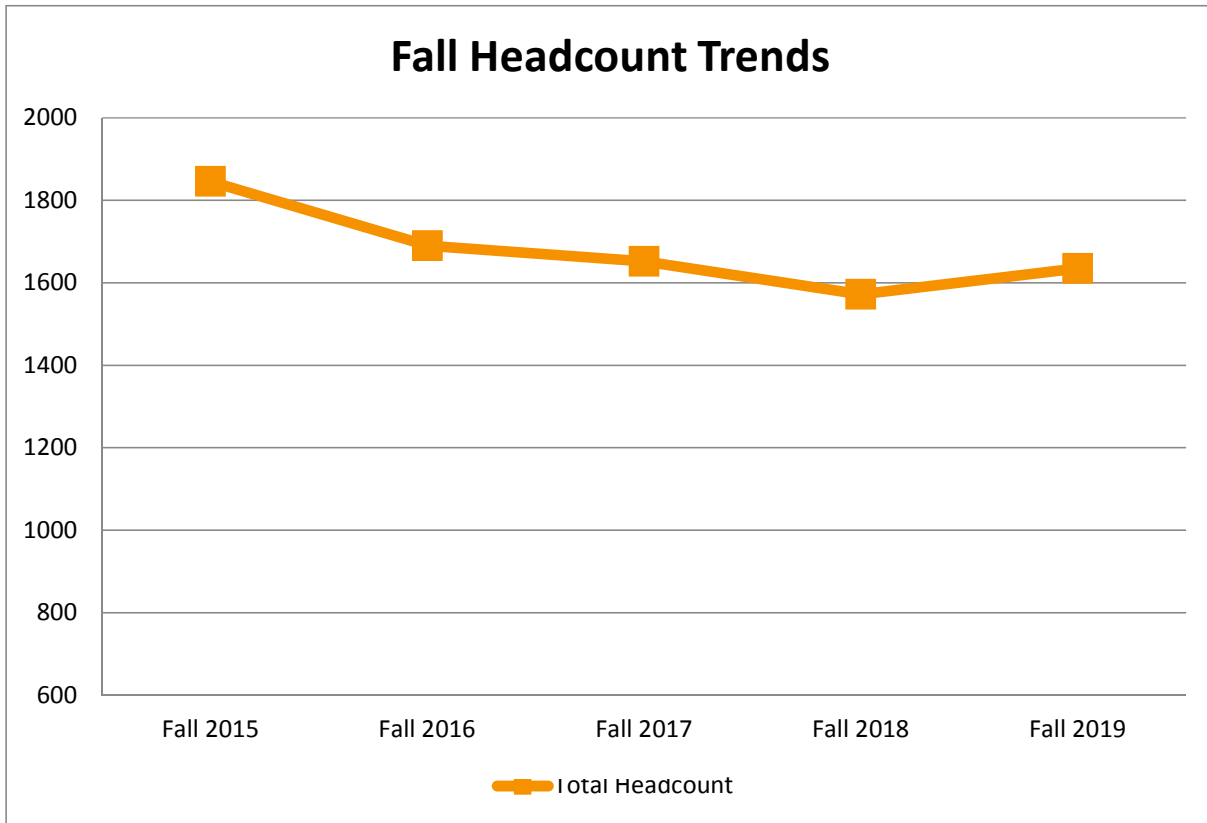

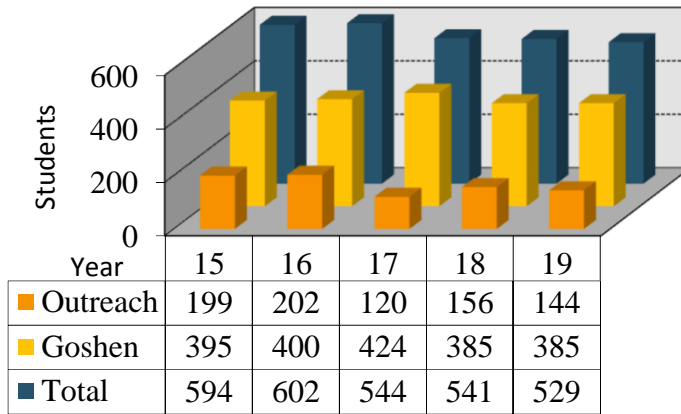
## FALL FULL-TIME HEADCOUNT

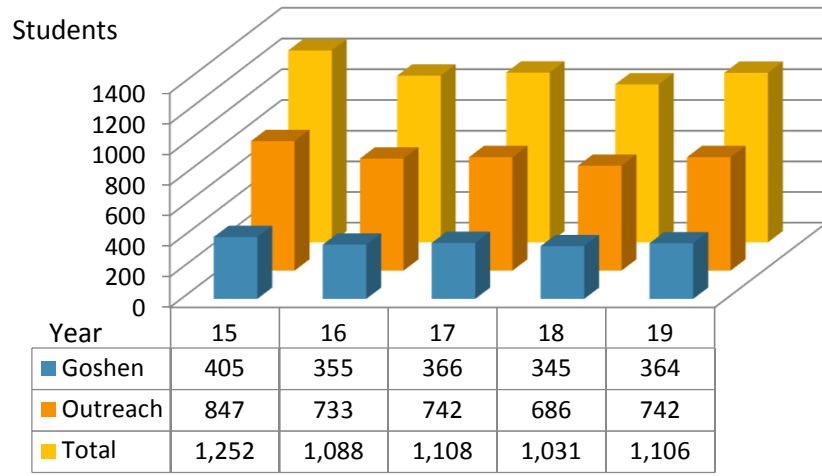
## FALL PART-TIME HEADCOUNT

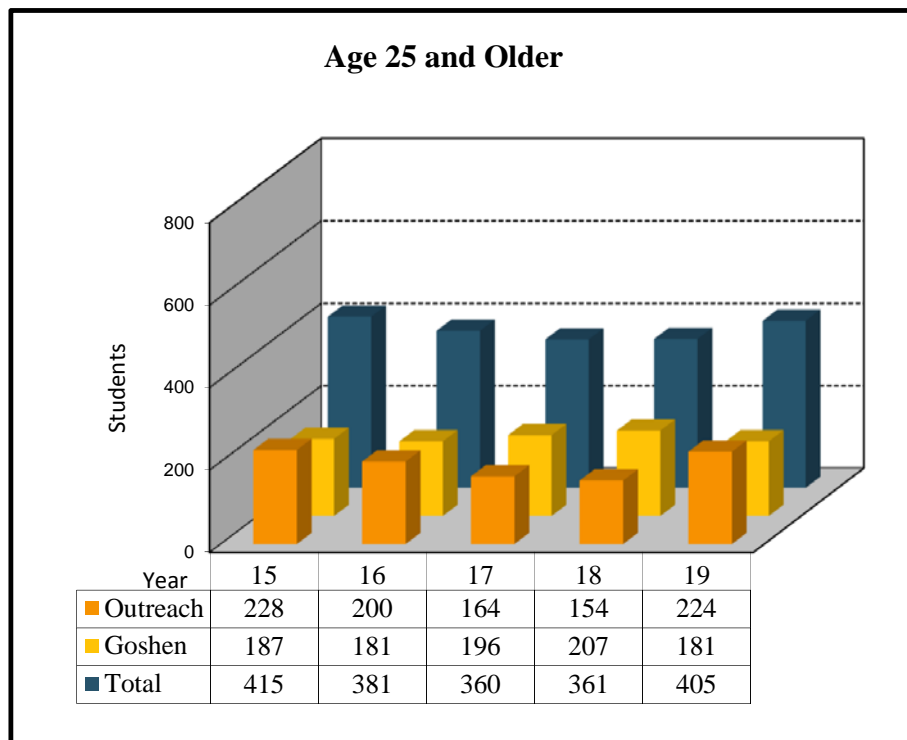
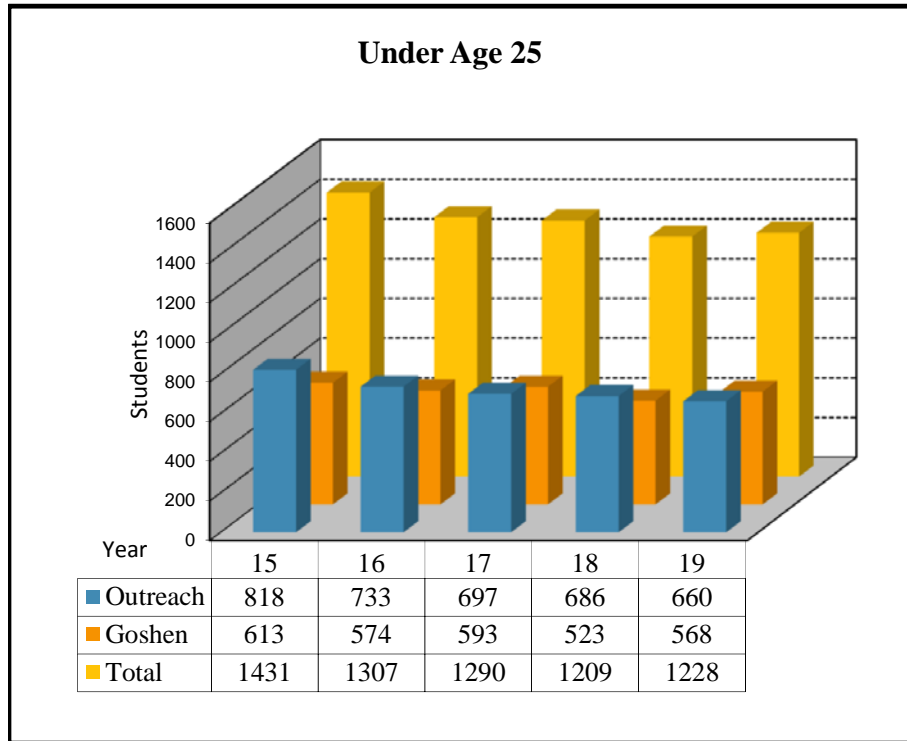

## FALL AGE UNDER 25/AGE 25 AND OLDER



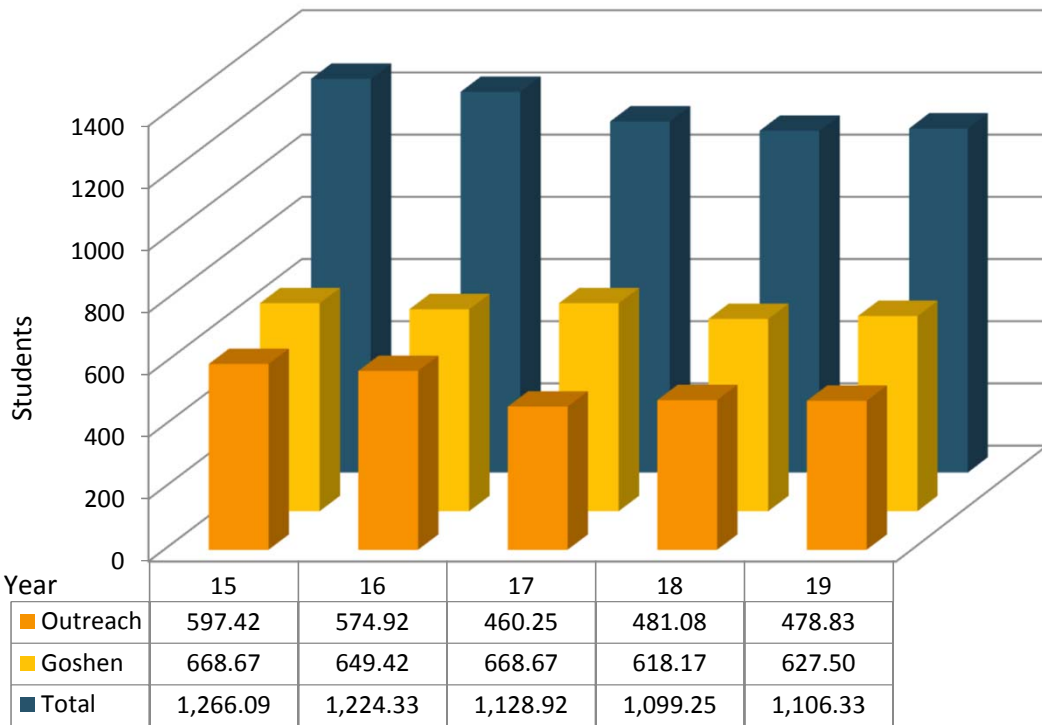
## FALL FTE BY LOCATION

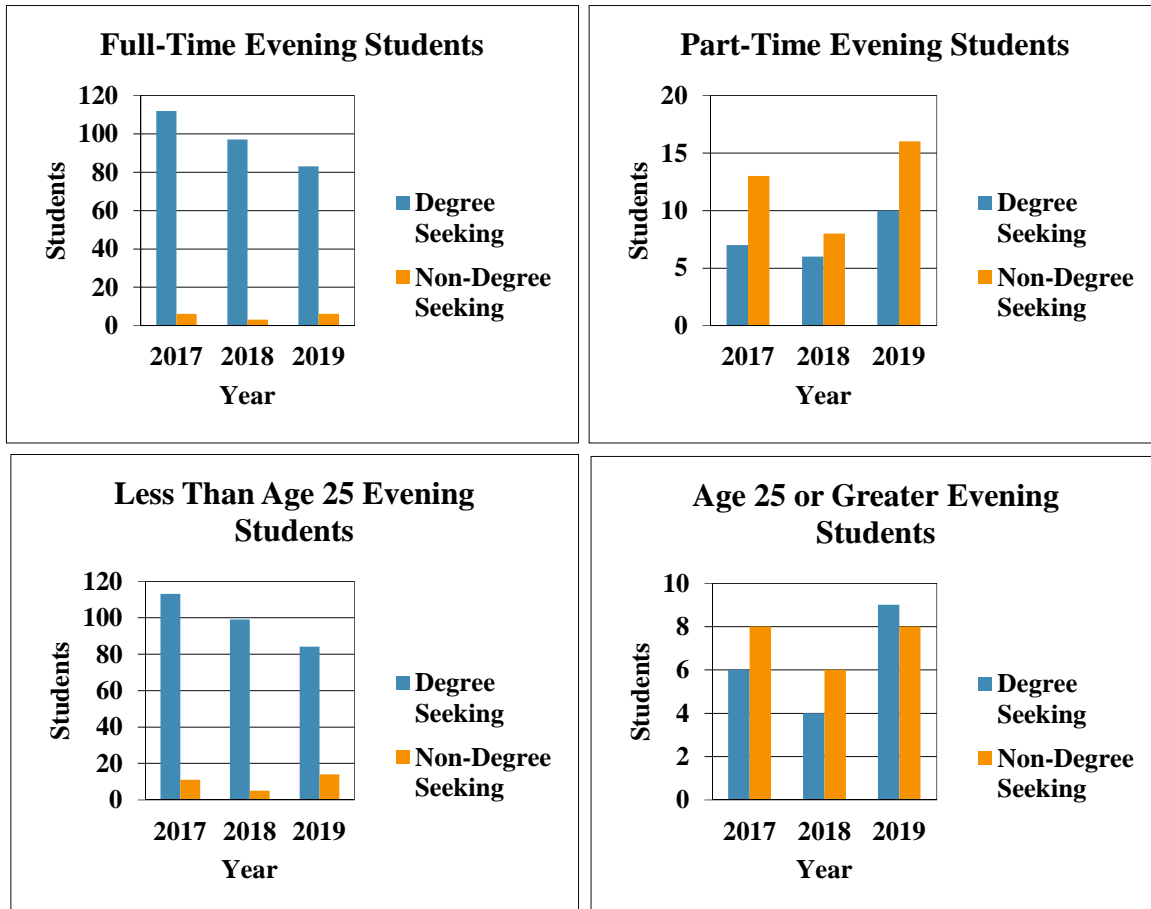

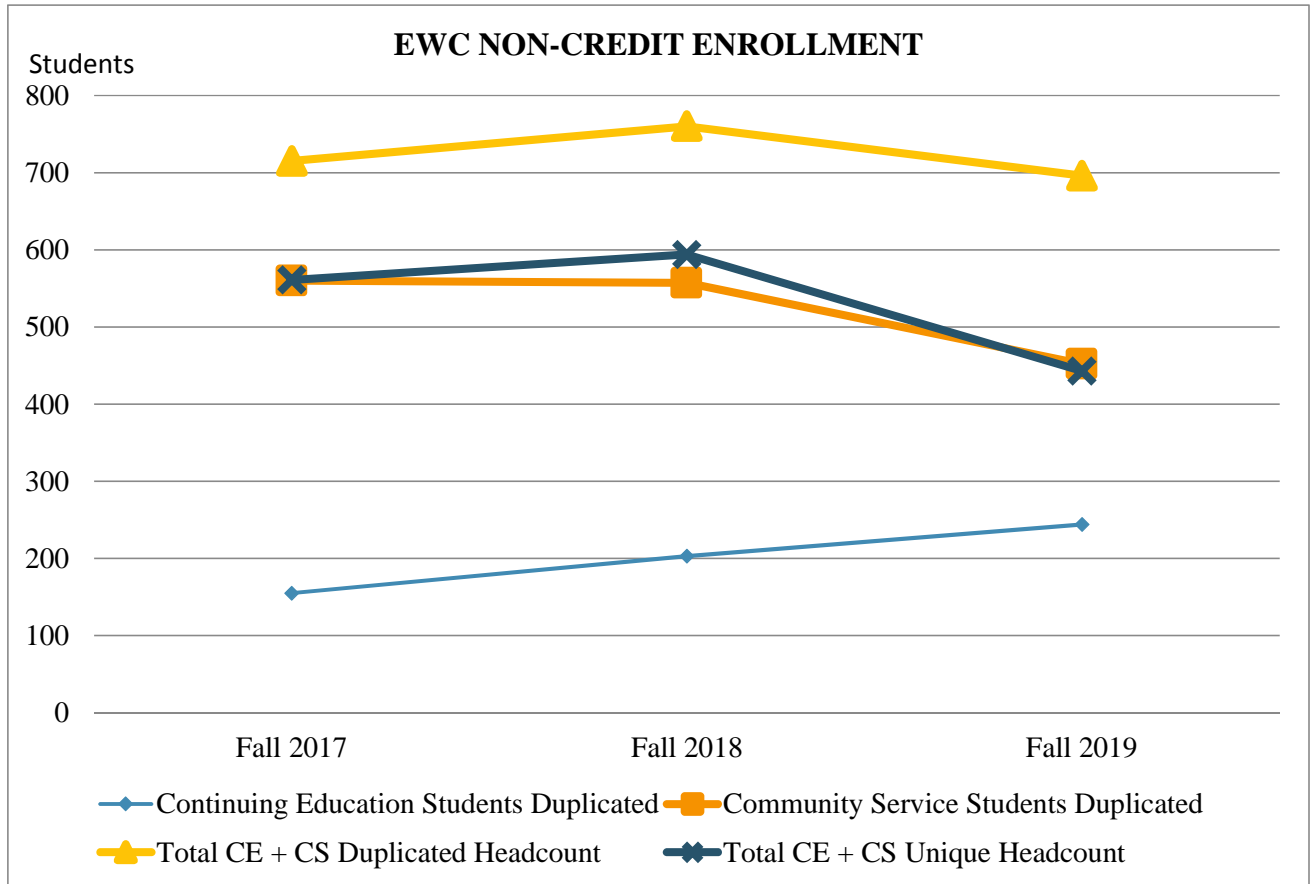
