 “The Code of Federal Regulations, Title 42, Part 483, Subpart D 483.150-160 **requires** that **if a CNA is employed or will be employed in a Long Term Care (LTC) facility for any part of the first 12 months after completing their CNA training program, the Long Term Care facility must pay for:** training, examination fees, and certification fees (including the Mandatory background check). If you are receiving grant\scholarship monies for this class, this does not apply.
