- IV. Fiscal Responsibility and the Foundational Elements of Strategic Planning - Dr. Bruce Leslie, ACCT Consultant

1. Dr. Leslie presented information on the 8 key trustee fiscal responsibilities to include: strategic plan, budget approval, financial and other controls (policies/admin rules), policies, funding sources, key patterns, trustee activism, and managing fluctuations.

Dr. Leslie also presented information on the 8 elements of an effective strategic plan to include: aspirational vision, a concise, efficient and focused mission, five or six values, a data decision system, a wildly important goal (WIG), five or six goals that achieve the WIG, strategies that achieve the goals that achieve the WIG, disciplined people engaged in disciplined thought and taking disciplined actions to create great organization that produce exceptional results (Jim Collins).
