<p>1. Introductions-Class of 2020 2. Committee Members WELCOME!</p>	<p>16 new students! (Bobbi and April in attendance) Introductions of committee.</p>
<p>3. ACEN Accreditation</p>	<p>Accreditation site visitors were very impressed with community support for our program. Suzey discussed the process (dings vs atta-boys, and ACEN changes). Accredited until 2023.</p>
<p>4. Graduates-NCLEX-RN results</p>	<p>14 start, 12 graduate, 11 took NCLEX, 9 passed first time, 1 passed after multiple attempts. All that have passed NCLEX have jobs. Our pass rate for the first cohort was 100% for program, 82% for NCLEX.</p>
<p>5. Night School Launch-Douglas and Torrington</p>	<p>Banner partnership with Torrington. Two faculty to be hired using WyN money for night school. Discussed contract with WMC. Caveats about afternoons for schools, MOB, and PH clinicals. Potential faculty are being recruited from Banner, WMC, and Scottsbluff (and Missy). Suzey is modeling this setup after Sheridan/Gillette programs. TEAS test and applications due by March 1, 2019. 8 students here and 8 in Torrington.</p>
<p>6. ACEN substantive change 7. Perkins Funds</p>	<p>Same educational options at both sites. Document to be completed and submitted by March 1, 2019 with site visit in Torrington by June 2019.</p> <p>This committee is a requirement for obtaining benefits from Perkins. Suzey and April went to OADN conference in Philly on Population Health. Very beneficial.</p>
