

# Fall 2020 Enrollment Summary

Institutional Research Office April 2021

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#### EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The Fall 2020 headcount decreased 10.7% and the FTE decreased 5.2% compared to Fall 2019. Full-time headcount was down 25 students and part-time headcount was down 150 students resulting in a total decrease of 175 students. The number of students who attended EWC for the first time in Fall 2020 was down 55 full-time students and down 54 part-time students. The number of students who had attended EWC any time prior to Fall 2020 was up 30 full-time students and down 96 part-time students. Goshen County was down 25 full-time and down 67 part-time students, and Outreach remained same in full-time and decreased by 83 part-time students. Goshen County decreased by 38.42 FTE, and Outreach decreased by 19.50 FTE. Outreach accounted for 43.8% of the total FTE.

Credit course offerings are provided as regular courses in both Goshen County and most of the 12 outreach sites. In addition, concurrent enrollment in the high schools, and distance learning courses are also offered. Goshen County courses generated 589.08 FTE of which 8.52% were from concurrent enrollment courses, 6.04% from evening courses, and 37.97% from distance education courses. Concurrent enrollment courses generated 54.90% of the 459.33 FTE from Outreach.

One of the challenges in scheduling courses is determining the time and delivery method that will best serve the largest number of students and accommodate the needs of non-traditional and site bound students. Some of the on-campus day students do enroll in distance learning and/or evening courses. The 84 distance education courses served 226 students living in EWC's outreach areas and 330 students living in Goshen County for a total of 556 students. However, 246 (74.5%) of these 330 students in Goshen County were also enrolled in regular on-campus day courses. Similarly, the 24 on-campus credit evening courses served a total of 100 students with 83 (83.0%) of these students also enrolled in regular on-campus day courses.

Developmental courses are offered for those students who do not have college level skills in reading, writing, and mathematics. There were 95 students enrolled in developmental courses, which accounted for 2.97% of the FTE. Of the 95 students enrolled in developmental courses, 79 of those students are seeking an associate degree or certificate.

The total Fall 2020 headcount was 1460 students. Of those students, 891 (61.0%) were non-degree seeking. High School students accounted for 784 (88.0%) students of the 891 non-degree seeking students. The programs with the largest enrollments were Interdisciplinary Studies, Welding & Joining Technology, and Veterinary Technology.

Eastern Wyoming College provides numerous non-credit and Workforce Development offerings. EWC's non-credit enrollment was 284 students compared to 443 students in Fall 2019. EWC's Workforce Development efforts provided 35 credit courses totaling 60.83 FTE and 5 non-credit courses to provide further educational opportunities for individuals in or preparing to enter the workforce.

The Fall 2020 full-time students came from 18 states and foreign countries. Most of the students came from 3 states: Wyoming, Nebraska and Colorado. Within Wyoming, the full-time students came from 21 counties, with the majority coming from Goshen, Converse, Laramie, Platte, Crook, Weston and Natrona.

The gender distribution for all credit students was 41.4% male and 58.6% female. The ethnicity distribution was 85.1% white non-Hispanic, 8.8% Hispanic, and 6.1% all others. The average age of students enrolled in credit courses was 21.4 with a 21.7 average for full-time students and a 21.2 average for part-time students.

#### **EWC Final Enrollment Fall 2020**

EWC experienced a decrease of 175 students (-10.7%) in total headcount as compared to Fall 2019. The total student headcount was 1460. The full-time enrollment went down 25 students and the part-time enrollment went down 150 students compared to Fall 2019. The enrollment in Fall 2020 was 141.8 below the 5 year average.




EWC experienced a decrease of 5.2% in FTE compared to Fall 2019. The FTE was 73.0 below the 5 year average.




#### FALL FULL-TIME HEADCOUNT



#### FALL PART-TIME HEADCOUNT

The part-time enrollment growth in Outreach was -83 (-11.2%) and in Goshen County it was -67 (-18.4%). The total part-time growth was -150 (-13.6%) as compared to last Fall. Outreach part-time headcount was 53.4 below the 5 yr avg and the Goshen County part-time heacount was 48.4 below the 5 yr avg. The total part-time headcount was 101.8 below the 5 yr avg.





#### FALL AGE UNDER 25/AGE 25 AND OLDER






#### **FALL FTE BY LOCATION**
















#### FALL HIGH SCHOOL STUDENT HEADCOUNT

High school students enrolled in EWC credit classes went up 19 compared to Fall 2019. Full-time HS students went up 5 and part-time HS students went up 14.


