EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The Fall 2022 headcount increased 4.8% and the FTE increased 0.8% compared to Fall 2021. Full-time headcount was down 2 students and part-time headcount was up 69 students resulting in a total increase of 67 students. The number of students who attended EWC for the first time in Fall 2022 was up 5 full-time students and up 33 part-time students. The number of students who had attended EWC any time prior to Fall 2022 was down 7 full-time students and up 36 part-time students. Goshen County was up 17 full-time and up 10 part-time students, and Outreach decreased by 19 full-time and increased by 59 part-time students. Goshen County FTE increased by 13.92 FTE, and Outreach decreased by 6.50 FTE. Outreach accounted for 44.4% and Goshen County accounted for 55.6% of the FTE.

Credit course offerings are provided as regular courses in both Goshen County and most of the 12 outreach sites. In addition, concurrent enrollment in the high schools, and distance learning courses are also offered. Goshen County courses generated 541.42 FTE of which 6.90% were from concurrent enrollment courses, 5.11% from evening courses, and 29.49% from distance education courses. Concurrent enrollment courses generated 63.68% of the 431.83 FTE from Outreach.

One of the challenges in scheduling courses is determining the time and delivery method that will best serve the largest number of students and accommodate the needs of non-traditional and site bound students. Some of the on-campus day students do enroll in distance learning and/or evening courses. The 76 distance education courses served 219 students living in EWC's outreach areas and 208 students living in Goshen County for a total of 427 students. However, 150 (72.1%) of these 208 students in Goshen County were also enrolled in regular on-campus day courses. Similarly, the 19 on-campus credit evening courses served a total of 91 students with 63 (69.2%) of these students also enrolled in regular on-campus day courses.

Developmental courses are offered for those students who do not have college level skills in reading, writing, and mathematics. There were 83 students enrolled in developmental courses, which accounted for 1.93% of the FTE. Of the 83 students enrolled in developmental courses, 45 of those students are seeking an associate degree or certificate.

The total Fall 2022 headcount was 1469 students. Of those students, 980 (66.7%) were non-degree seeking. High School students accounted for 855 (87.2%) students of the 980 non-degree seeking students. The programs with the largest enrollments were Welding & Joining Technology and Veterinary Technology.

Eastern Wyoming College provides numerous non-credit and Workforce Development offerings. EWC's non-credit enrollment was 274 students. EWC's Workforce Development efforts provided 23 credit courses totaling 39.58 FTE and 11 non-credit courses meeting for a total of 57.00 contact hours to provide further educational opportunities for individuals in or preparing to enter the workforce.

The Fall 2022 full-time students came from 21 states and foreign countries. Most of the students came from 4 states: Wyoming, Nebraska, Colorado and South Dakota. Within Wyoming, the full-time students came from 21 counties, with the majority coming from Goshen, Converse, Laramie, Platte and Weston.

The gender distribution for all credit students was 41.2% male and 58.8% female. The ethnicity distribution was 84.4% white non-Hispanic, 8.4% Hispanic, and 7.2% all others. The average age of students enrolled in credit courses was 21.1 with a 20.4 average for full-time students and a 21.4 average for part-time students.

EWC Final Enrollment Fall 2022

EWC experienced an increase of 67 students (4.8%) in total headcount as compared to Fall 2021. The total student headcount was 1469. The full-time enrollment went down 2 students and the part-time enrollment went up 69 students compared to Fall 2021. The enrollment in Fall 2022 was 40.2 below the 5 year average.

EWC experienced an increase of 0.8% in FTE compared to Fall 2021. The FTE was 66.1 below the 5 year average.

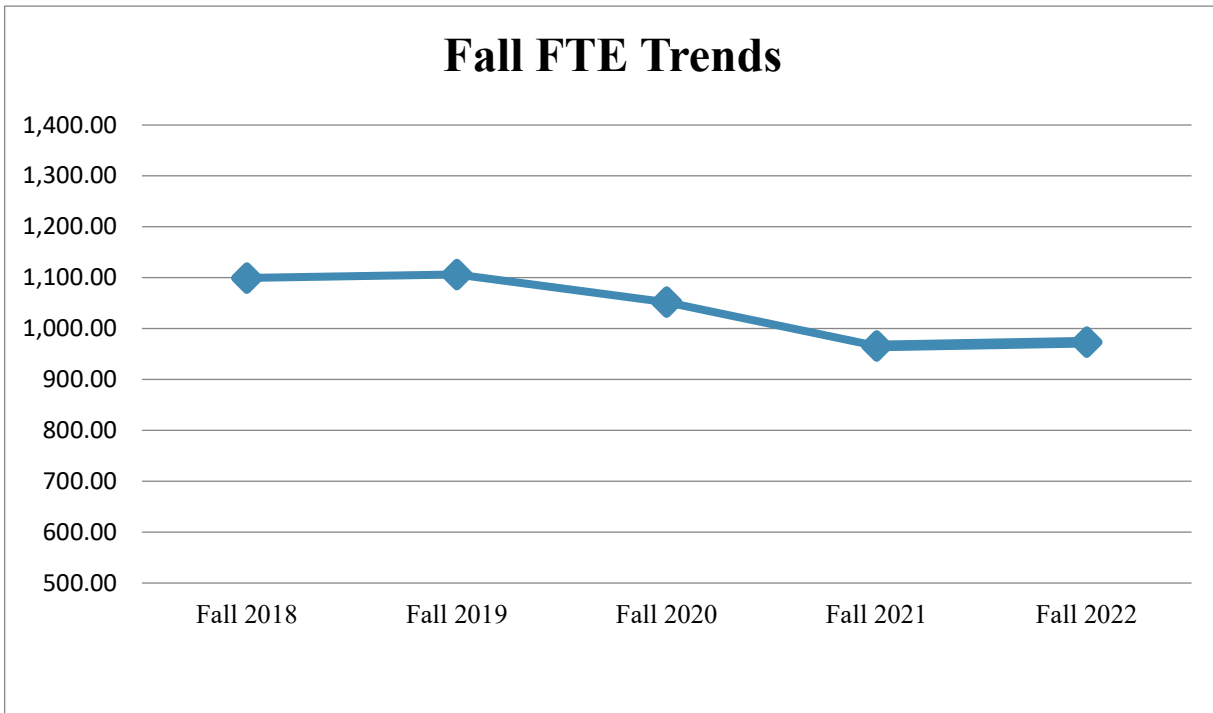
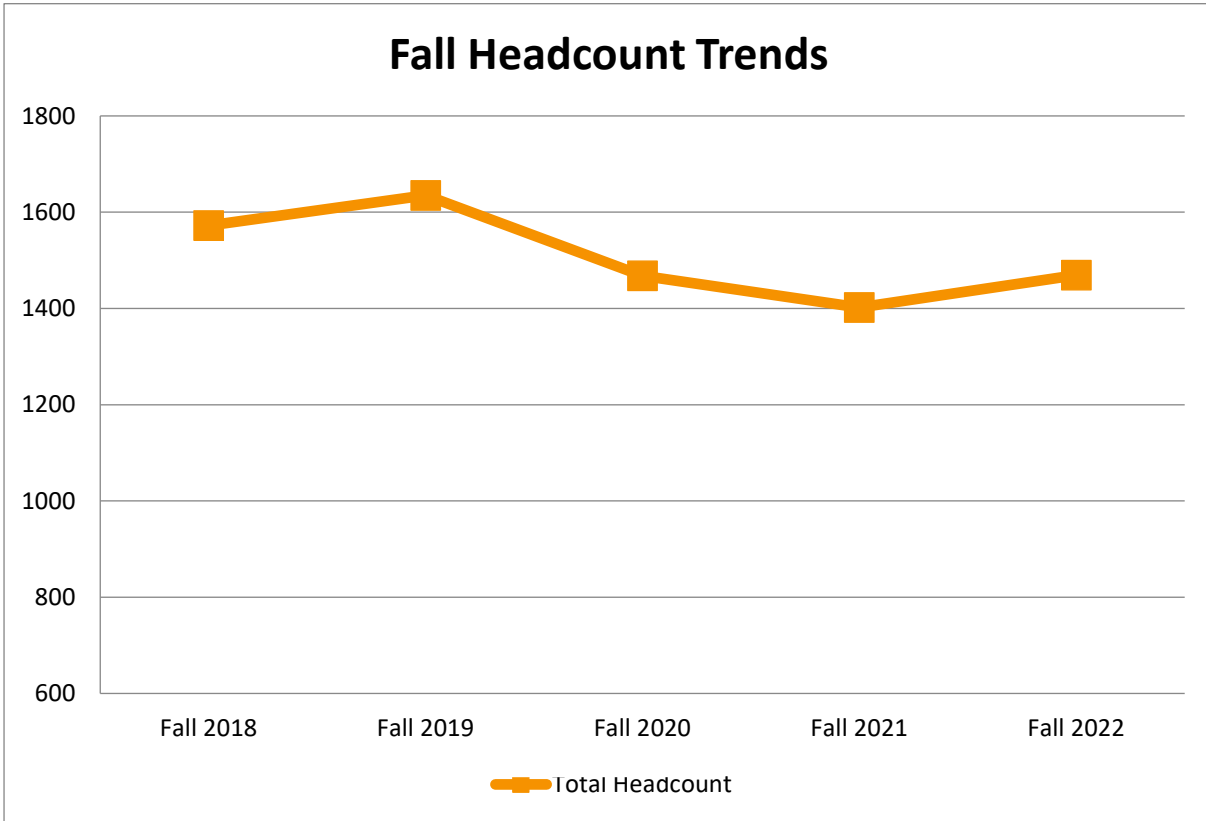

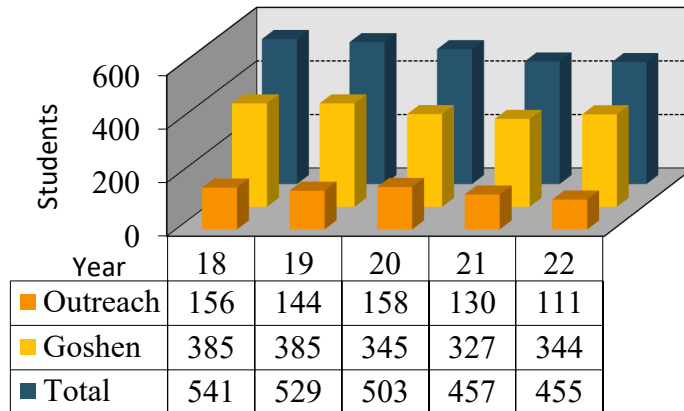
FALL FULL-TIME HEADCOUNT

The full-time enrollment growth in Outreach was -19 (-14.6%) and in Goshen County it was 17 (5.2%). The total full-time growth was -2 (-0.4%) as compared to last Fall. Outreach full-time headcount was 28.8 below the 5 year avg. Goshen County was 13.2 below the 5 year avg for an overall 42.0 below the 5 year avg.

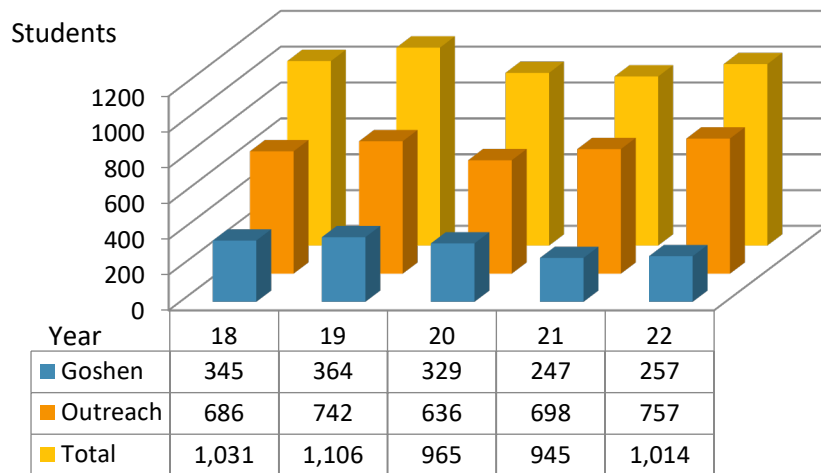
FALL PART-TIME HEADCOUNT

The part-time enrollment growth in Outreach was 59 (8.5%) and in Goshen County it was 10 (4.0%). The total part-time growth was 69 (7.3%) as compared to last Fall. Outreach part-time headcount was 53.2 above the 5 yr avg and the Goshen County part-time headcount was 51.4 below the 5 yr avg. The total part-time headcount was 1.8 above the 5 yr avg.

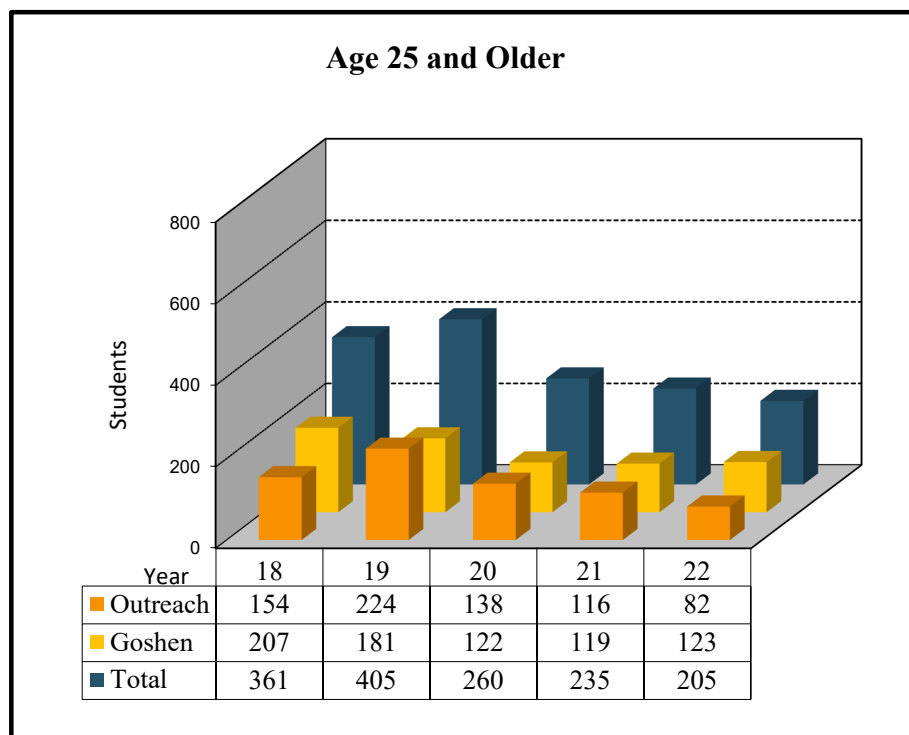
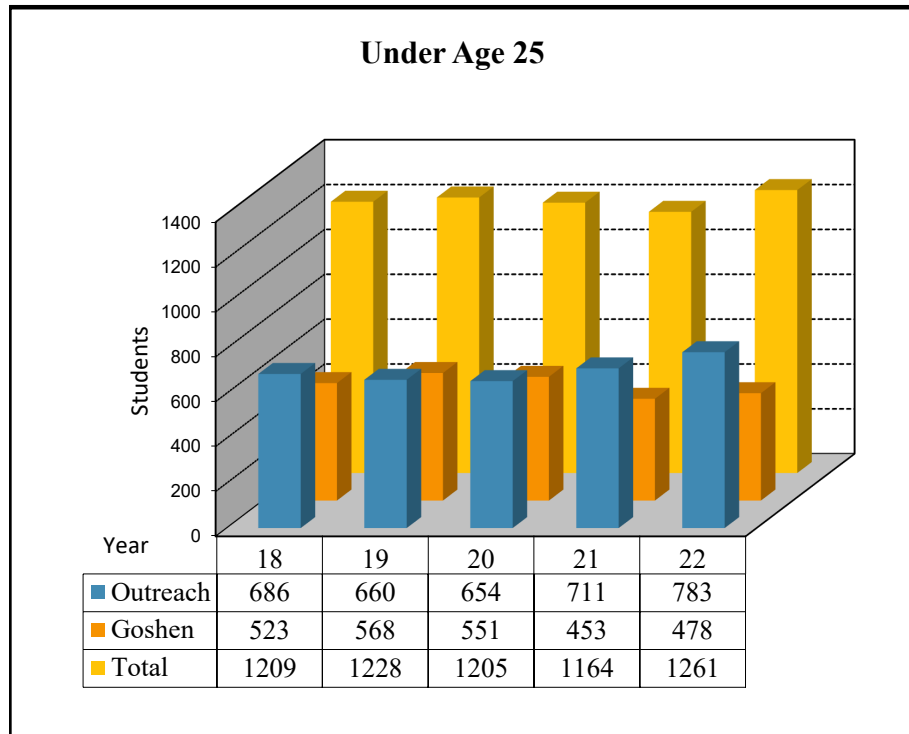

FALL AGE UNDER 25/AGE 25 AND OLDER



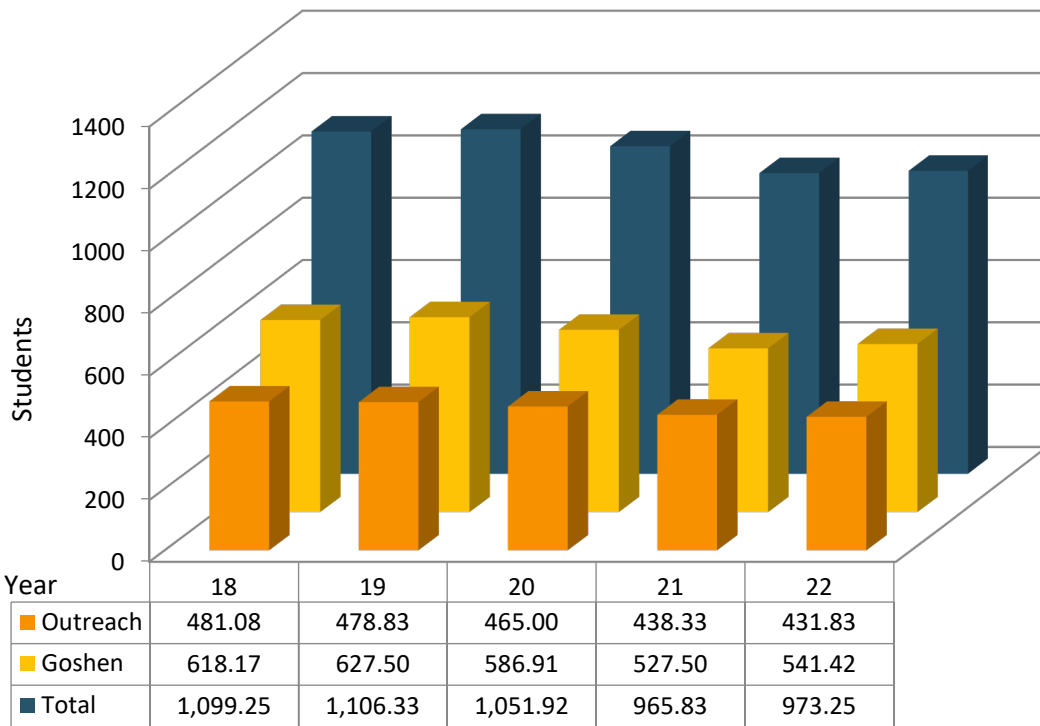
FALL FTE BY LOCATION

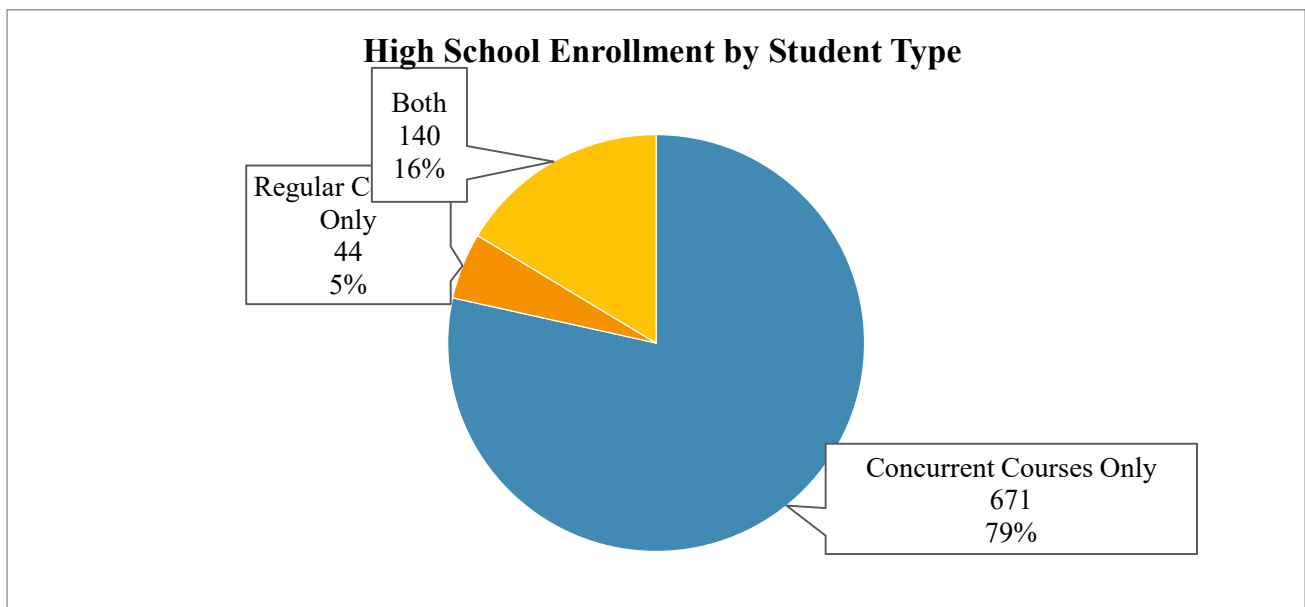
High school students enrolled in EWC credit classes went up 74 compared to Fall 2021. Full-time HS students went down 9 and part-time HS students went up 83.

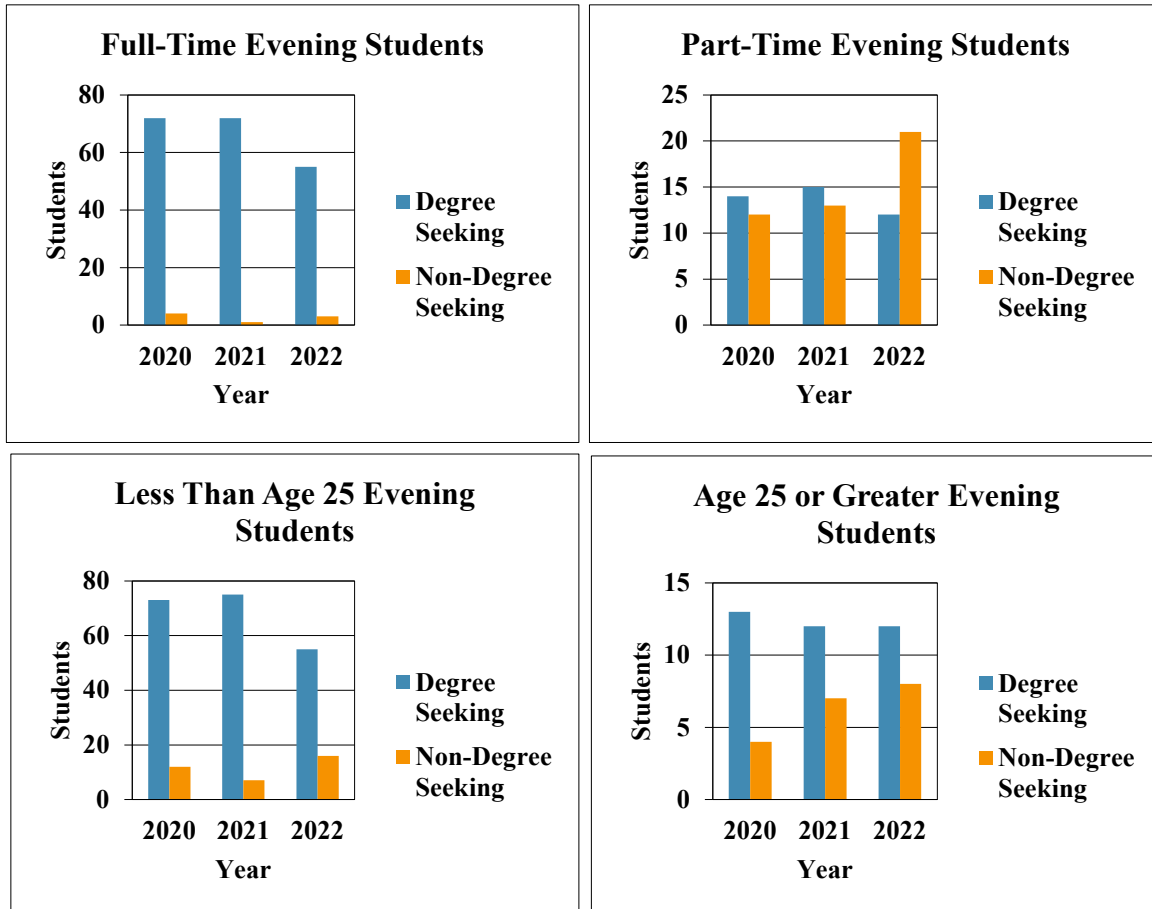

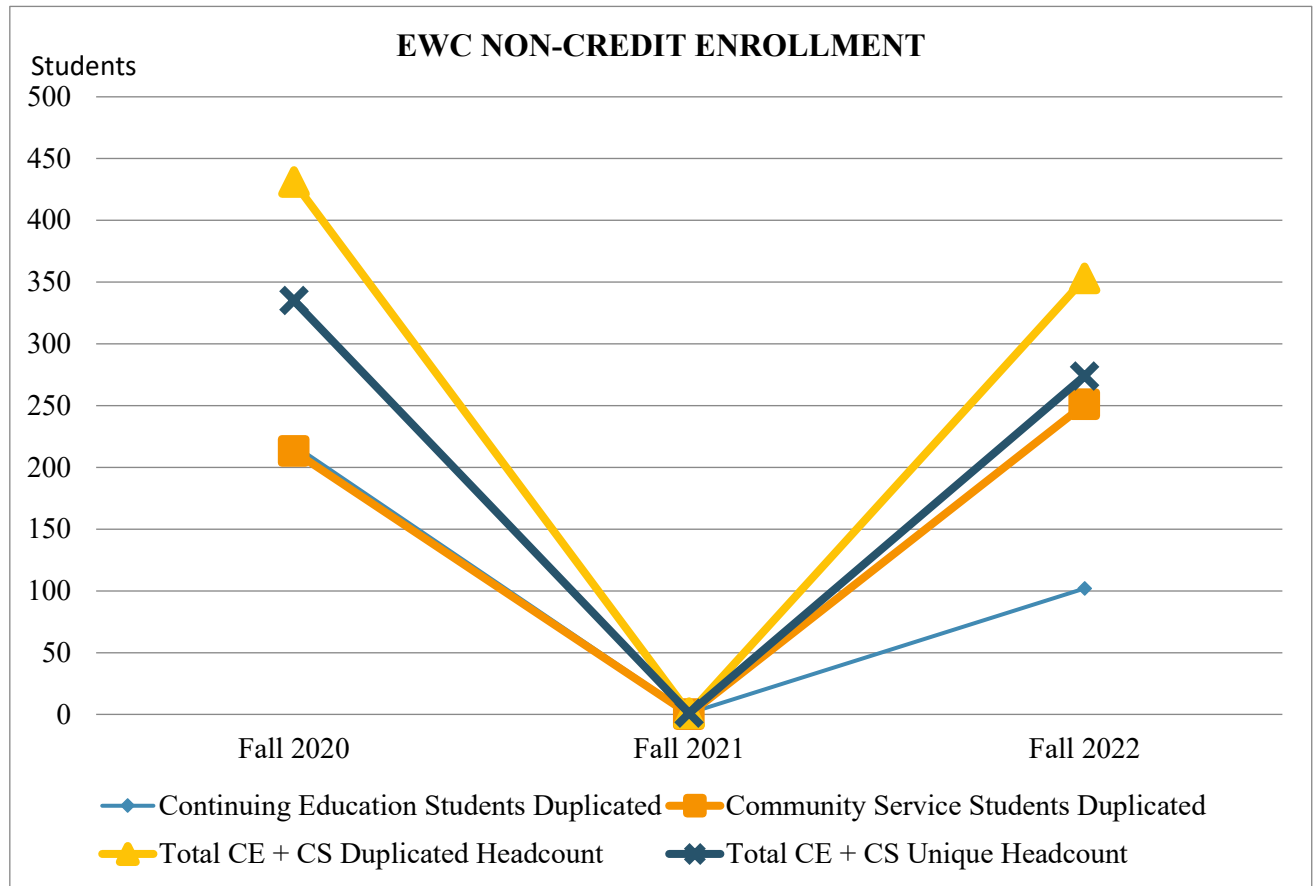
