## EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The Spring 2020 headcount decreased 2.4\% and the FTE decreased 6.6\% compared to Spring 2019. Full-time headcount was down 51 students and part-time headcount was up 14 students resulting in a total decrease of 37 students. The number of first time first year students in Spring 2020 was down 8 full-time student and down 40 part-time students. The number of students who were not first time first year was down 43 full-time students and up 54 part-time students. Goshen County was down 5 full-time students and up 6 part-time students, and Outreach down 46 full-time students and up 8 part-time students. Goshen County FTE increased by 5.42 FTE and Outreach decreased by 75.50 FTE. Outreach accounted for $43.7 \%$ and Goshen County accounted for $56.3 \%$ of the FTE.

Credit course offerings are provided as regular courses in both Goshen County and most of the 12 outreach sites. In addition, concurrent enrollment in the high schools, and distance learning courses are also offered. Goshen County courses generated 553.92 FTE of which $7.63 \%$ were from concurrent enrollment courses, 5.75\% from evening courses, and 35.76\% from distance education courses. Concurrent enrollment courses generated 50.43\% of the 430.17 FTE from Outreach.

The 77 distance education courses served 206 students living in EWC’s outreach areas or Douglas campus and 263 students living in Goshen County for a total of 469 students. However, 187 (77.1\%) of the 263 students in Goshen County were also enrolled in regular day courses. Distance education courses meet the needs of busy working adults and also regular on-campus students.

Developmental courses are offered for those students who do not have college level skills in reading, writing, and mathematics. There were 73 students enrolled in developmental courses, which accounted for $1.96 \%$ of the FTE. Of the 73 students enrolled in developmental courses, 46 of those students are seeking an associate degree or certificate.

The total Spring 2020 headcount was 1529 students. Of those students, 977 (63.9\%) were nondegree seeking. High School students accounted for 764 (78.2\%) students of the 977 non-degree seeking students. The programs with the largest enrollments were Interdisciplinary Studies, Welding \& Joining Technology, and Veterinary Technology.

Eastern Wyoming College provides numerous non-credit and Workforce Development offerings. EWC's non-credit enrollment was 410 students compared to 572 students in Spring 2019. EWC's Workforce Development efforts provided 29 credit courses totaling 80.67 FTE and 6 non-credit courses meeting for a total of 16.00 contact hours to provide further educational opportunities for individuals in or preparing to enter the workforce.

The Spring 2020 full-time students came from 19 states and foreign countries. Most of the students came from five states: Wyoming, Nebraska, Colorado, South Dakota, and Montana. Within Wyoming, the full-time students came from 22 counties, with the majority coming from Goshen, Converse, Platte, Laramie and Crook.

The gender distribution for all credit students was $41.3 \%$ male and $58.7 \%$ female. The ethnicity distribution was $86.2 \%$ white non-Hispanic, $8.2 \%$ Hispanic, and $5.6 \%$ all others. The average age of students enrolled in credit courses was 23.6 with a 21.9 average for full-time students and a 24.4 average for part-time students.

## EWC Final Enrollment Spring 2020

EWC experienced a decrease of 37 students ( $-2.4 \%$ ) in total headcount as compared to Spring 2019. The total student headcount was 1529. The fulltime enrollment went down 51 students and the part-time enrollment went up 14 students compared to Spring 2019. The enrollment in Spring 2020 was 10.4 below the 5 year average.

## SPRING FULL-TIME HEADCOUNT

The full-time enrollment growth in Outreach was -46 (-26.6\%) and in Goshen County it was -$5(-1.5 \%)$. The total full-time growth was $-51(-9.9 \%)$ as compared to last Spring. Outreach full-time headcount was 11.8 below the 5 year avg. Goshen County was 4.2 below the 5 year avg for an overall 16.0 below the 5 year avg.

The part-time enrollment growth in Outreach was 8 (1.1\%) and in Goshen County it was 6 (1.7\%). The total part-time growth was $14(1.3 \%)$ as compared to last Spring. Outreach parttime headcount was 9.6 above the 5 yr avg and the Goshen County part-time heacount was 4.0 below the 5 yr avg. The total part-time headcount was 5.6 above the 5 yr avg.

The enrollment growth of students less than age 25 in Outreach was 6 ( $0.9 \%$ ), it was 28 (5.7\%) in Goshen County and it was 34 (3.0\%) in EWC totally. The enrollment growth of students age 25 and older in Outreach was -41 (-19.2\%), in Goshen County it was -26 ( $-13.0 \%$ ) and it was -67 ( $-16.2 \%$ ) in EWC totally.
