#### **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

The Spring 2022 headcount decreased 0.7% and the FTE decreased 1.8% compared to Spring 2020. Full-time headcount was down 5 students and part-time headcount was down 4 students resulting in a total decrease of 9 students. The number of first time first year students in Spring 2022 was up 36 full-time student and up 4 part-time students. The number of students who were not first time first year was down 41 full-time students and down 8 part-time students. Goshen County was up 3 full-time students and down 42 part-time students, and Outreach down 8 full-time students and up 38 part-time students. Goshen County FTE decreased by 17.58 FTE and Outreach increased by 1.33 FTE. Outreach accounted for 46.6% and Goshen County accounted for 53.4% of the FTE.

Credit course offerings are provided as regular courses in both Goshen County and most of the 12 outreach sites. In addition, concurrent enrollment in the high schools, and distance learning courses are also offered. Goshen County courses generated 465.17 FTE of which 7.34% were from concurrent enrollment courses, 4.57% from evening courses, and 39.11% from distance education courses. Concurrent enrollment courses generated 55.12% of the 405.50 FTE from Outreach.

The 85 distance education courses served 265 students living in EWC's outreach areas or Douglas campus and 229 students living in Goshen County for a total of 494 students. However, 162 (70.7%) of the 229 students in Goshen County were also enrolled in regular day courses. Distance education courses meet the needs of busy working adults and also regular on-campus students.

Developmental courses are offered for those students who do not have college level skills in reading, writing, and mathematics. There were 68 students enrolled in developmental courses, which accounted for 0.78% of the FTE. Of the 68 students enrolled in developmental courses, 26 of those students are seeking an associate degree or certificate.

The total Spring 2022 headcount was 1370 students. Of those students, 906 (66.1%) were nondegree seeking. High School students accounted for 729 (80.5%) students of the 906 non-degree seeking students. The programs with the largest enrollments were Interdisciplinary Studies, Welding & Joining Technology, Veterinary Technology and Agriculture.

Eastern Wyoming College provides numerous non-credit and Workforce Development offerings. EWC's non-credit enrollment was 196 students compared to 297 students in Spring 2021. EWC's Workforce Development efforts provided 43 credit courses totaling 68.50 FTE and 14 non-credit courses meeting for a total of 14.00 contact hours to provide further educational opportunities for individuals in or preparing to enter the workforce.

The Spring 2022 full-time students came from 17 states and foreign countries. Most of the students came from four states: Wyoming, Nebraska, Colorado and South Dakota. Within Wyoming, the full-time students came from 23 counties, with the majority coming from Converse, Goshen, Laramie, Platte and Weston.

The gender distribution for all credit students was 43.4% male and 56.6% female. The ethnicity distribution was 84.3% white non-Hispanic, 8.9% Hispanic, and 6.8% all others. The average age of students enrolled in credit courses was 22.8 with a 21.6 average for full-time students and a 23.3 average for part-time students.

# **EWC Final Enrollment Spring 2022**

EWC experienced a decrease of 9 students (-0.7%) in total headcount as compared to Spring 2021. The total student headcount was 1370. The full-time enrollment went down 5 students and the part-time enrollment went down 4 students compared to Spring 2021. The enrollment in Spring 2022 was 98.4 below the 5 year average.




#### EWC experienced a decrease of 1.8% in FTE compared to Spring 2021. The FTE was 88.1 below the 5 year average.






#### SPRING FULL-TIME HEADCOUNT

The full-time enrollment growth in Outreach was -8 (-7.3%) and in Goshen County it was 3 (1.1%). The total full-time growth was -5 (-1.3%) as compared to last Spring. Outreach full-time headcount was 29.4 below the 5 year avg. Goshen County was 32.6 below the 5 year avg for an overall 62.0 below the 5 year avg.



#### SPRING PART-TIME HEADCOUNT

The part-time enrollment growth in Outreach was 38 (5.7%) and in Goshen County it was -42 (-13.2%). The total part-time growth was -4 (-0.4%) as compared to last Spring. Outreach part-time headcount was 18 above the 5 yr avg and the Goshen County part-time heacount was 54.4 below the 5 yr avg. The total part-time headcount was 36.4 below the 5 yr avg.





#### **SPRING AGE UNDER 25/AGE 25 AND OLDER**






#### **SPRING FTE BY LOCATION**








#### SPRING HIGH SCHOOL STUDENT HEADCOUNT

High school students enrolled in EWC credit classes went up 145 compared to Spring 2021. Full-time HS students went up 1 and part-time HS students went up 144.



#### SPRING HIGH SCHOOL STUDENT HEADCOUNT





# SPRING DEVELOPMENTAL STUDENTS BY AGE


