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EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The Spring 2018 headcount decreased 2.3% and the FTE decreased 2.6%. Full-time headcount was down 17 students and part-time headcount was down 19 students resulting in a total decrease of 36 students. The number of first time students in Spring 2017 was up 4 full-time student and down 7 part-time students. The number of students who had attended EWC anytime prior to Spring 2017 was down 21 full-time students and down 12 part-time students. Goshen County was down 1 full-time students and down 7 part-time students, and Outreach decreased by 16 full-time students and decreased by 12 part-time students. Goshen County FTE decreased by 3.66 FTE, and Outreach decreased by 22.50 FTE. Outreach accounted for 43.9% and Goshen County accounted for 56.1% of the FTE.

Credit course offerings are provided as regular courses in both Goshen County and most of the 12 outreach sites. In addition, concurrent enrollment in the high schools, and distance learning courses are also offered. Goshen County courses generated 552.75 FTE of which 4.96% were from concurrent enrollment courses, 4.88% from evening courses, and 33.42% from distance education courses. Concurrent enrollment courses generated 46.84% of the 433.25 FTE from Outreach.

The 115 distance education courses served 200 students living in EWC's outreach areas or Douglas campus and 240 students living in Goshen County for a total of 440 students. However, 184 (76.7%) of the 240 students in Goshen County were also enrolled in regular day courses. Distance education courses meet the needs of busy working adults and also regular on-campus students.

Developmental courses are offered for those students who do not have college level skills in reading, writing, and mathematics. There were 81 students enrolled in developmental courses, which accounted for 2.03% of the FTE. Of the 81 students enrolled in developmental courses, 50 of those students are seeking an associate degree or certificate.

The total Spring 2018 headcount was 1498 students. Of those students, 948 (63.3%) were non-degree seeking. High School students accounted for 647 (68.2%) students of the 948 non-degree seeking students. The programs with the largest enrollments were Interdisciplinary Studies, Welding & Joining Technology, and Veterinary Technology.

Eastern Wyoming College provides numerous non-credit and Workforce Development offerings. EWC's non-credit enrollment was 651 students compared to 698 students in Spring 2017. EWC's Workforce Development efforts provided 57 credit courses totaling 113.00 FTE and 12 non-credit courses meeting for a total of 111.00 contact hours to provide further educational opportunities for individuals in or preparing to enter the workforce.

The Spring 2018 full-time students came from 17 states and foreign countries. Most of the students came from five states: Wyoming, Nebraska, Colorado, South Dakota, and Montana. Within Wyoming, the full-time students came from 23 counties, with the majority coming from Goshen, Converse, Crook, Weston and Laramie.

The gender distribution for all credit students was 44.6% male and 55.4% female. The ethnicity distribution was 87.4% white non-Hispanic, 7.9% Hispanic, and 4.7% all others. The average age of students enrolled in credit courses was 24.7 with a 21.7 average for full-time students and a 26.1 average for part-time students.

EWC FINAL ENROLLMENT SPRING 2018

EWC experienced a decrease of 36 students (-2.3%) in total headcount as compared to Spring 2017. The total student headcount was 1498. The full-time enrollment went down 17 students and the part-time enrollment went down 19 students compared to Spring 2017. The enrollment in Spring 2018 was 136.6 below the 5 year average.




EWC experienced a decrease of 2.6% in FTE compared to Spring 2017. The FTE was 73.4 below the 5 year average.




SPRING FULL-TIME HEADCOUNT

The full-time enrollment growth in Outreach was -16 (-10.7%) and in Goshen County it was -1 (-0.3%). The total full-time growth was -17 (-3.5%) as compared to last Spring. Outreach full-time headcount was 2.4 below the 5 year avg. Goshen County was 27.6 below the 5 year avg for an overall 30.0 below the 5 year avg.



SPRING PART-TIME HEADCOUNT

The part-time enrollment growth in Outreach was -12 (-1.7%) and in Goshen County it was -7 (-2.0%). The total part-time growth was -19 (-1.8%) as compared to last Spring. Outreach part-time headcount was 48.8 below the 5 yr avg and the Goshen County part-time heacount was 57.8 below the 5 yr avg. The total part-time headcount was 106.6 below the 5 yr avg.

SPRING AGE UNDER AGE 25/AGE 25 AND OLDER





SPRING AGE UNDER 25/AGE 25 AND OLDER






SPRING FTE BY LOCATION
















SPRING HIGH SCHOOL STUDENT HEADCOUNT

High school students enrolled in EWC credit classes went down 10 compared to Spring 2017. Full-time HS students went up 8 and part-time HS students went down 18.


