3. Ferrilli Update regarding Colleague system management- Dr. Hawes and Emily Baker

Ferrelli's Software Implementations and Process Improvements
The meeting included an update from Ferrelli, a consulting firm working with the college on various software implementations and process improvements. Ferrelli has been integrated into the college team for 9 months, focusing on optimizing the use of Colleague (the college's main software system) and implementing new software solutions. Key areas of

work include the business office, financial aid, and registrar's office. Ferrelli is also assisting with the implementation of several new software tools, including Helio Campus for outcomes analysis, NextGen for scholarship management, Element 451 for student applications, and SmartPlan for student planning and advising. The college leadership emphasized how these new tools will significantly improve processes and student services.

4. EWC Academic Catalog Update for Academic Year 2025-2026 -VP Hansen

John Hansen spoke about the updates to the catalog, and that it will be ready for publication in the near future. Hansen spoke about improvements to the catalog process, and that with these changes the catalog will be easier to update and it will decrease the time it takes to turn around time to get this printed and out to the public.

5. Sodexo food services update- VP Hansen

Danielle and Julian from Sodexo provide an update on the food service operations at Eastern Wyoming College. They highlight improvements made in the past year, including implementing culinary standards, opening a retail outlet, and enhancing meal plan tracking. They introduce the new on-site manager, Gonzalo, and discuss survey results showing overall satisfaction with the food service. Future plans include introducing innovative dining experiences, improving spaces, and increasing community engagement. The presenters emphasize their alignment with the college's mission and commitment to student success.
