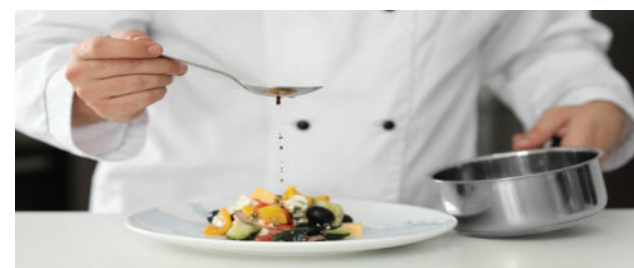

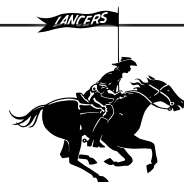

Placement Exams

(Accuplacer): Students who plan to enroll in a lab science, math and/or an English class will need to take the Accuplacer placement exam if they haven't met ACT or prerequisite requirements for the class. Call your Outreach Coordinator to schedule a time to take the exam. The cost to take the exam is \$20.
