## WELDING

### SMAW Basics for Adults

Dive into the fundamentals of Shielded Metal Arc Welding (SMAW), commonly known as stick welding, in this hands-on 5-week evening course. Designed for adults seeking to explore welding as a hobby or skill, this class emphasizes practical application, safety, and tool proficiency. Whether you are aiming to enhance your DIY projects or considering a new skill set, this course provides a solid foundation in welding. Join us and ignite your passion for metalworking!

#### WHAT YOU'LL LEARN:

- Proper setup and operation of SMAW equipment
- Selecting and handling electrodes (e.g., E6010, E7018)
- Executing basic welds in flat and horizontal positions
- Understanding the role of flux and slag in weld quality
- Identifying and correcting common welding defects
- Essential safety practices and tool maintenance

**TOOLS & SAFETY GEAR:** All necessary equipment and safety gear are provided, including welding machines, electrodes, gloves, jackets, and helmets. However, you are welcome to bring your own personal gear if preferred. Electrodes and metal will also be provided, again you may bring your own, but it is not necessary.

**ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:** This course focuses exclusively on SMAW. Should there be sufficient interest, we can discuss offering a follow-up class on Gas Metal Arc Welding (GMAW).

## Payment Options

Payment for tuition and fees can be made online through your student account on MyEWC, by check, or by phone using a credit/debit card by calling the EWC Business Office at 307.532.8205. If you are paying by credit/debit card, you may use Visa, MasterCard, or Discover. All tuition and fees must be paid in full at the beginning of each semester and before the student attends classes. All checks should be made payable to Eastern Wyoming College. Payment plans may be available from the EWC Business Office for those students who qualify. Failure to pay tuition and fees, or have an approved payment plan in place before the student attends classes may result in a late payment charge. Please contact the EWC Business Office for additional information.

## Refunds

Tuition and Activity & Use/Technology Fees are refunded on a course-by-course basis, and are determined by the length of the course and the first meeting day of the course.

**TUITION:** For courses which meet the full (16 week) semester, tuition is refunded in full for 8 calendar days beginning with the first day of the class. Thereafter, there is no refund of tuition. For courses which are offered for less than a full (16 week) semester, the tuition refund will be prorated.

**ACTIVITY & USE/TECHNOLOGY FEES:** For courses which meet the full (16 week) semester, activity and use/technology fees are refunded in full for 14 calendar days beginning with the first day of the class. For courses which are offered for less than a full (16 week) semester, the activity & use/technology fees refund will be prorated.

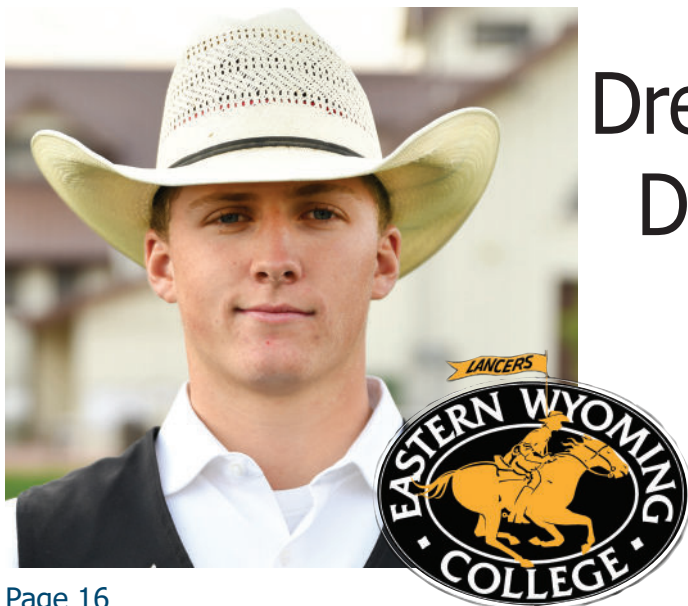

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# EWC CONCURRENT & DUAL ENROLLMENT CLASSES

**Wyoming believes in its young people and proves it by offering qualified high school students a chance to take college classes for FREE.** Concurrent and Dual Enrollment classes are offered through Eastern Wyoming College. These classes count for both high school and college credit. Concurrent Enrollment courses are taught by EWC approved high school teachers at Upton High School, and Newcastle High School. Dual Enrollment courses are college courses taught by EWC instructors or EWC approved high school teachers outside of the school day.

- **Students** get a chance to try out college classes and earn credits toward a two year or four year degree or career/technical certificate.
- **Students** will discover this program is a two-for-one deal: classes count for both high school graduation and college credit.
- **Students** will be challenged through rigorous college classes while getting a running start at college.
- **If a student** is a senior, they will avoid “senioritis” by taking relevant classes and starting a college degree or certificate program.
- **Students** will save money when they go to college because they will not have to stay as long or pay for as many classes. And, the Hathaway Scholarship dollars will stretch further. Students can enroll in classes at Upton and Newcastle High Schools if they are eligible and have met course requirements.

# Discover A Future in Health Care

**E**astern Wyoming College offers a focused healthcare program in **NURSING**, **CERTIFIED NURSING ASSISTANT (CNA)**, and **MEDICAL ASSISTANT (MA)** training.

The **NURSING** program leads to an Associate Degree in Nursing (ADN), preparing students to become Registered Nurses eligible for the NCLEX-RN exam, with a pathway to a BSN through the ReNEW curriculum.

The **CNA** program provides essential skills for patient care in long-term and acute settings, with advanced options like CNA II and Medication Assistant certification.

The **MA** program is a one-year certificate that prepares students for both clinical and administrative roles in healthcare, qualifying them for national certification exams.
